PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1135.2), which relates to recognition of service specialty license plates; modifying eligibility standard for the Disabled Veterans License Plate; creating the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary license plate; providing for eligibility; limiting to certain type of vehicle; providing for design of license plate; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1135.3), which relates to demonstration of support or affiliation specialty license plates; transferring authority for certain Jenks Trojans License Plate to another section of law; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1135.5), which relates to demonstration of support and financial assistance specialty license plates; creating the Disabled American Veterans License Plate; creating the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate; creating the John Rex Charter Elementary School License Plate; recreating the Jenks Trojans License Plate; creating the Bixby Spartans License Plate; creating the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation License Plate; establishing plates as financial assistance license plates; providing for design of license plates; allowing and providing limitations on personalization of license plates; requiring certain portion of fees be deposited in certain funds; authorizing certain licensing

1 agreements; authorizing and limiting certain
2 payments; creating Disabled American Veterans License
3 Plate Revolving Fund; creating the Prisoner of War
4 and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving Fund;
5 placing funds with the Military Department;
6 considering certain funds appropriated; exempting
7 funds from certain budgetary requirements; requiring
8 certain budgetary procedures; providing for
9 codification; and providing an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
12 last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
13 2015, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
15 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
16 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
17 provided by this section.

18 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
19 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
20 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
21 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
22 registered for the current year.

23 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
24 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
25 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
26 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain

1 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
2 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
3 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
4 amateur radio operator license plates.

5 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
6 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
7 applications for special license plates authorized under this
8 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
9 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
10 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
11 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
12 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
13 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
14 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
15 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
16 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

17 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
18 follows:

19 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
21 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
22 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
23 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
24 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having

1 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
2 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
3 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
4 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
5 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
6 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
7 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
8 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
9 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

10 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
12 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
13 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
14 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

15 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
17 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
18 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
19 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

20 4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates
21 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of
22 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of
23 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air
24 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to

1 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have
2 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
3 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present
4 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services
5 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form ~~(DD)~~
6 214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates
7 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but
8 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

9 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
10 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
11 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
12 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
13 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
14 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

15 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
17 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
18 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
19 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
20 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
21 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
22 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
23 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
24 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in

1 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
2 of one (1) ton or less;

3 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
5 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
6 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
7 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
8 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
9 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
10 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
11 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
12 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
13 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
14 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
15 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
16 provided by this section for special license plates;

17 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
19 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
20 the United States as being:

- 21 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
22 7, 1941,
- 23 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
24 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,

1 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
2 exceed three (3) miles, and

- 3 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
4 States Armed Forces.

5 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
6 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
7 less;

8 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
9 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
10 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
11 States as being:

- 12 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
13 of 1945,
14 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
15 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
16 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
17 States Armed Forces.

18 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
19 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

20 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
21 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
22 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
23 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
24 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such

1 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
2 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
3 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
4 registration after the initial issue;

5 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
7 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
8 the United States as being:

9 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
10 1944,

11 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
12 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
13 participation cannot be verified by the United States
14 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
15 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
16 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
17 the person applying for the license plate, and

18 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
19 States Armed Forces.

20 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
21 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
24 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse

1 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
2 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
3 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
4 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
5 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
6 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
7 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
8 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
9 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
10 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
11 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

12 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
14 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
15 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
16 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
17 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
18 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
19 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
20 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
21 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
22 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
23 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

1 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
3 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
4 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
5 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
6 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
7 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
10 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
11 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
12 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

13 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
15 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
16 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
17 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
18 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
19 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
20 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
21 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
22 education police department by either an identification card or
23 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
24 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for

1 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
2 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
3 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
4 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
5 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
6 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
7 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

8 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
10 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
11 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
12 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
13 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
14 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
15 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
16 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

17 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
18 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
19 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
20 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
21 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
22 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
23 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
24 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.

1 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
2 "WORLD WAR II";

3 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
5 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
6 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
7 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
8 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
9 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
10 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
11 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

12 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
13 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
14 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
15 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
16 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
17 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
18 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
19 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
20 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

21 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
23 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
24

1 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
2 be produced upon application;

3 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
5 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
6 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
7 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
8 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
9 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
10 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
11 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
12 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
13 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
14 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
15 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
16 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

17 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
18 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
19 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars
20 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
21 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
22 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
23 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;
24

1 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
3 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
4 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
5 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
6 of one (1) ton or less;

7 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
9 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
10 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
11 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

12 23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
13 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
14 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
15 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

16 24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
18 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
19 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
20 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
21 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

22 25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
23 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
24 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-

1 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
2 the Ninety-Nines;

3 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
4 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
5 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
6 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
7 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
8 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
9 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
10 less;

11 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
13 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
14 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
15 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
16 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

17 28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
19 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
20 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
21 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

22 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
24

1 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
2 United States Secretary of Defense;

3 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
5 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
6 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
7 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
8 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
9 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
11 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
12 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
13 district number;

14 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
16 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
17 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
18 disability rating of ~~fifty percent (50%)~~ ten percent (10%) or more,
19 regardless which agency pays the disability benefits, or that such
20 veteran has been awarded a vehicle by the United States government
21 or receives a grant from the United States Department of Veterans
22 Affairs for the purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected
23 disability rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye.
24 Such persons may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans

1 license plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license
2 plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated
3 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of
4 any deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since
5 remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death,
6 divorce, or annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of
7 Dependency and Indemnity Compensation from the United States
8 Department of Veterans Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans
9 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
10 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
11 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
12 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
13 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of
14 this license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

15 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
16 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
17 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
18 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
19 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
20 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
21 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
22 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
23 the Tax Commission;

1 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
3 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
4 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
5 designed in consultation with the Association;

6 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
8 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
9 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
10 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
11 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
12 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
13 Academy;

14 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
15 be designed and issued to any person~~r~~ holding a valid operator's
16 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
17 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
18 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
19 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
20 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
21 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
22 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
23 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
24 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call

1 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
2 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
3 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
4 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
5 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee
6 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
7 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
8 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license
9 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
10 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
11 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any
12 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
13 right to such special identification plates herein provided for
14 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
15 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

16 36. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
18 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
19 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
20 Oklahoma;

21 37. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
23 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
24 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or

1 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
2 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
3 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
4 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.

6 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

7 49. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates
8 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon
9 who present proper certification from the United States Department
10 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action
11 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat
12 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
13 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 license plate for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
20 less. The license plate design shall include both gold and silver
21 dolphins to represent both officer and enlisted service members; ~~and~~

22 51. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License
23 ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
24 honorably discharged or present member of the United States Navy

1 Seabees or Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a
2 United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate
3 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
4 less. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the
5 Military Department of the State of Oklahoma; and

16 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
17 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration
18 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

19 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
20 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
21 2015, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
23 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
24 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or

1 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
2 subject as provided by this section.

3 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
4 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
5 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
6 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
7 registered for the current year.

8 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
9 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
10 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
11 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
12 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
13 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
14 issued on a staggered system.

15 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
16 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
17 applications for special license plates authorized under this
18 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
19 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
20 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
21 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
22 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
23 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
24 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
4 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
5 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
6 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
7 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
8 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
9 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
10 removed from the vehicle.

11 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
12 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
13 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
14 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications
15 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
16 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
17 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
18 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
19 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
20 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

1 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
2 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by
3 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise
4 provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows:
5 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be
6 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be

11 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
12 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
13 2015, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
15 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
16 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
17 financial assistance as provided by this section.

18 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
19 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
20 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
21 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
22 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

23 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
24 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall

1 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
2 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
3 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
4 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
5 issued on a staggered system.

6 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
7 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
8 applications for special license plates authorized under this
9 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
10 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
11 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
12 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
13 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
14 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
15 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
16 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
17 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

18 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
19 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
20 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
21 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
22 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
23 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
24

1 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
2 removed from the vehicle.

3 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
4 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
5 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
6 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
7 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
8 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
9 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
10 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
11 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

12 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
13 follows:

14 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
16 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
17 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
18 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

19 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
20 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
21 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
23 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
24 general public environmental education program created pursuant to

1 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
3 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
4 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
5 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
6 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
7 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
8 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
9 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
10 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

11 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
12 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
13 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
14 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
15 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
16 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
17 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
18 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
19 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
20 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
21 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
22 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
23 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
24 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief

1 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
2 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
5 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
6 the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living Memorial;

7 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
9 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
12 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
13 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
14 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
15 plates.

16 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
17 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
18 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
21 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
22 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
23 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
24 the prevention of child abuse.

1 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
2 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

3 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
4 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
6 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
7 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
8 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
9 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
10 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
11 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
12 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
14 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
15 issued;

16 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
18 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
19 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
20 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

21 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
23 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
24 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving

1 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
2 Oklahoma;

3 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
5 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
6 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
7 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
8 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
9 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
11 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
12 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
13 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
14 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
15 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
16 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
17 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
18 collected shall be apportioned to the ~~Emergency Medical Technician~~
19 Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2
20 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
23 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
24

1 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
2 Revolving Fund;

3 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
6 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
7 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
8 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
9 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
10 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
11 provide services to crime victims;

12 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
14 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
15 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
16 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
17 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
18 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
19 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

20 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
21 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
22 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
24 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in

1 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
2 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
3 Section 1104.4 of this title;

4 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
5 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
6 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
7 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
8 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
9 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
10 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
11 Section 1104.3 of this title;

12 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
14 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
16 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
17 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
18 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
19 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
20 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
23 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
24 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
2 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
3 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
4 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
5 follows:

- 6 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
7 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 8 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
9 Education Revolving Fund,
- 10 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
11 Career Technology Fund, and
- 12 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
13 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
14 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the

1 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
2 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
3 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
4 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
5 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.

6 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
7 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
8 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
9 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
10 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
11 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
12 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
13 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
14 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

15 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
17 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
18 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
19 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
20 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
21 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
22 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
23 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
24 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide

1 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
2 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

3 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
4 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
5 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
6 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
7 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
8 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
10 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
11 of this title;

12 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
13 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
14 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
15 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
16 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
17 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
18 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
19 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

20 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
21 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
22 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
23 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
24 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and

1 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
2 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
3 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
4 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
5 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
6 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
7 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
8 specifically for created families;

9 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
10 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
11 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
12 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
13 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
14 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
15 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
16 this title;

17 24. Future Farmers of America License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
19 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future
20 Farmers of America). The license plates shall be designed in
21 consultation with the Oklahoma FFA Foundation Board of Directors.
22 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
23 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.7 of this title;

1 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
3 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
4 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
5 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
6 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
7 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
8 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
9 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
10 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
11 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
12 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

13 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
15 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
16 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
17 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
18 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
19 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
20 Section 1104.8 of this title;

21 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
22 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
23 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
24 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person

1 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
2 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
3 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
4 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
5 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
6 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
7 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
8 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
9 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
10 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
14 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
15 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
16 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter

20 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the Prisoner of War
21 and Missing in Action License Plates shall be deposited in the
22 Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving Fund
23 created in subsection B of this section.
24

1 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
2 fund for the Oklahoma Military Department to be designated the
3 "Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate Revolving
4 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
5 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
6 Department pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this
7 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
8 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for
9 the purpose of providing grants to the Oklahoma Chapter of Honor
10 Flights for the purpose of transporting Oklahoma veterans to
11 Washington, D.C., to visit those memorials dedicated to honor their
12 service and sacrifices. Expenditures from the fund shall be made
13 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
14 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
15 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

16 C. The Oklahoma Legislature hereby declares that the Oklahoma
17 Chapter of Honor Flights provides an important service to the
18 inhabitants of this state as a community and further finds that the
19 services performed by the Oklahoma Chapter of Honor Flights are
20 adequate consideration for the funds received pursuant to this
21 section.

22 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
