9 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68  
10 O.S. 2011, Section 2862, which relates to the county  
11 board of equalization; modifying requirements related  
12 to training; providing for forfeiture of office based  
13 on failure to meet requirements; and providing an  
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 2862, is  
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 2862. A. The members of the county board of  
19 equalization for each county in the state, before entering upon  
20 their duties, shall subscribe to the oath required of other county  
21 officers.

22 B. Each member of the county board of equalization shall be  
23 required to attend and successfully complete a course for purposes  
24 of instructing the members about the duties imposed on the board by  
law. The course shall be developed by the Oklahoma State University

1 Center for Local Government Technology and shall include subjects  
2 similar to those prescribed by law for certification of county  
3 assessors and their deputies. Failure of a county board of  
4 equalization member to successfully complete such course within  
5 eighteen (18) months of the date as of which the member was  
6 appointed shall result in forfeiture of the office and the vacancy  
7 shall be filled in the manner provided by law. In addition to the  
8 initial training requirement, each member of the county board of  
9 equalization shall attend and successfully complete the same or a  
10 similar course of instruction within eighteen (18) months of any  
11 subsequent term to which the member is appointed. Failure of a  
12 county board of equalization member to complete such course of  
13 instruction shall result in forfeiture of office and the vacancy  
14 shall be filled in the manner provided by law.

15 C. The members of county boards of equalization in all counties  
16 having an assessed valuation of Two Billion Dollars  
17 (\$2,000,000,000.00) or more shall receive as compensation an amount  
18 not to exceed Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) per day. The members of  
19 county boards of equalization in all other counties may receive as  
20 compensation an amount not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day,  
21 such amount to be established by the boards.

22 D. In addition to the amounts specified in subsection C of this  
23 section, members of county boards of equalization shall be  
24 reimbursed for each mile of travel to and from their residences to

1 the place of meeting of the board for each session attended at the  
2 rate provided for other county officers. The members shall also be  
3 reimbursed for each mile of necessary travel in the performance of  
4 their official duties at the same rate.

5 E. The total number of days in each year for which the members  
6 of a county board of equalization may be paid shall be as follows:

7 1. In counties having an assessed valuation of Forty Million  
8 Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) or less, not to exceed forty (40) days;

9 2. In counties having an assessed valuation of more than Forty  
10 Million Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) and not more than Eighty Million  
11 Dollars (\$80,000,000.00), not to exceed forty-five (45) days; and

12 3. In counties having an assessed valuation of more than Eighty  
13 Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00), not to exceed ninety (90) days.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
