8 An Act relating to insurance; requiring mandated
9 health insurance coverage only apply to the Oklahoma
10 Employees Health Insurance Plan; directing the Office
11 of Management and Enterprise Services to submit
12 report; providing report contents; defining term;
13 providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6011 of Title 36, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Any mandated health insurance coverage signed into law after
20 November 1, 2016, for specific health services, benefits, diseases,
21 copay structure, formulary structure or for certain providers of
22 health care services shall apply only to the Oklahoma Employees
23 Health Insurance Plan, for a period of at least one (1) year,
24 beginning with the next effective date of the Oklahoma Employees
Health Insurance Plan year.

1 B. On or before June 1, after the mandate for health insurance
2 coverage has been applied for a one-year period, the Office of
3 Management and Enterprise Services shall submit to the President Pro
4 Tempore of the State Senate and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
5 Representatives, a report indicating the impact the mandated
6 coverage has had on the Oklahoma Employees Health Insurance Plan,
7 including data on the utilization and costs of the mandated
8 coverage.

9 C. The report for assessing the impact of a proposed mandate of
10 health coverage shall include at the minimum and to the extent that
11 information is available, the following:

- 12 1. The social impact, including:
 - 13 a. the extent to which the treatment or service is
14 generally utilized by a significant portion of the
15 population,
 - 16 b. the extent to which such insurance coverage is already
17 generally available,
 - 18 c. if coverage is not generally available, the extent to
19 which the lack of coverage results in persons being
20 unable to obtain necessary health care treatment,
 - 21 d. if the coverage is not generally available, the extent
22 to which the lack of coverage results in unreasonable
23 financial hardship on those persons needing treatment,

- e. the level of public demand for the treatment or service,
- f. the level of public demand for group insurance coverage of the treatment or service,
- g. the level of interest of collective bargaining organizations in negotiating privately for inclusion of this coverage in group contracts, and
- h. the impact of indirect costs which are costs other than premiums and administrative costs, on the question of the costs and benefits of coverage;

2. The financial impact, including:

- a. the extent to which insurance coverage that included the mandated health insurance benefit would increase or decrease the cost of the treatment or service,
- b. the extent to which the proposed coverage might increase appropriate use of the treatment or service,
- c. the extent to which insurance coverage of the health care service or provider can be reasonably expected to increase or decrease the insurance premium and administrative expenses of policyholders, and
- d. the impact of this coverage on the total cost of health care.

D. As used in this section, "Oklahoma Employees Health Insurance Plan" shall have the same meaning as "Health Insurance

1 Plan" as defined in Section 1303 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma State
2 Statute.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.

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
