11 An Act relating to the Office of Juvenile Affairs;
12 amending Section 1, Chapter 201, O.S.L. 2014 (10A
13 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 2-7-616), which relates to
14 the Office of Juvenile Affairs' charter school;
15 authorizing Office of Management and Enterprise
16 Services to exempt the Office of Juvenile Affairs
17 from certain conflicting statutes; directing the
18 Office of Management and Enterprise Services to take
19 action to assist the Office of Juvenile Affairs in
20 operating the charter school; providing an effective
21 date; and declaring an emergency.

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 201, O.S.L.
2014 (10A O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 2-7-616), is amended to read as
follows:

Section 2-7-616. A. For the purposes of establishing and
operating a charter school, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-

1 130 et seq. of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Board of
2 Juvenile Affairs may serve as the governing body of the charter
3 school and may take any action necessary to serve in such capacity
4 and in accordance with rules of the State Board of Education. The
5 Board of Juvenile Affairs may promulgate rules as necessary for the
6 establishment and operation of such charter school and shall
7 establish policies and provide oversight for any such charter
8 school.

9 B. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs
10 shall provide for the administration and operation of any charter
11 school established and operated by the Office of Juvenile Affairs.

12 C. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs may
13 employ instructional and administrative personnel necessary for the
14 operation of a charter school and may contract with such personnel
15 for the terms and conditions of their employment or for the services
16 provided. Instructional and administrative personnel employed by
17 the Office of Juvenile Affairs shall be in the unclassified service.
18 Such personnel shall be eligible for membership or participation in
19 the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma.

20 D. To implement the provisions of this section, the Office of
21 Management and Enterprise Services shall have the authority to
22 exempt the Office of Juvenile Affairs from specific statutes that
23 are in conflict with requirements of operating a charter school.
24 The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall take any

1 action necessary to assist the Office of Juvenile Affairs in
2 operating a charter school, including but not limited to:

- 3 1. Establishing a special agency account; and
4 2. Authorizing a surety bond as required by Section 5-116a of
5 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
