10 PROPOSED SUBCOMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.  
12 2011, Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5, as last amended by  
13 Sections 1 and 2, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S.  
14 Supp. 2015, Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5), which relate  
15 to specialty license plates; creating the Sepsis  
16 Awareness License Plate; creating the Oklahoma Dental  
17 Association Mission of Mercy License Plate; providing  
18 for design; providing for deposit of certain fee;  
19 creating Oklahoma Dental Association Mission of Mercy  
20 License Plate Revolving Fund; placing fund with the  
21 State Department of Health; considering certain funds  
22 appropriated; authorizing certain expenditures from  
23 fund; exempting fund from certain budgetary  
24 requirements; requiring certain budgetary procedures;  
clarifying reference; providing for codification; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as  
2 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.  
3 2015, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
6 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or  
7 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other  
8 subject as provided by this section.

9 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
10 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
11 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
12 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
13 registered for the current year.

14 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
15 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
16 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
17 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
18 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
19 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
20 issued on a staggered system.

21 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
22 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
23 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
24 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's

1 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
2 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
3 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
4 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
5 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
6 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
7 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

9 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
10 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
11 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of  
12 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
13 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license  
14 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
15 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
16 removed from the vehicle.

17 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special  
18 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special  
19 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission  
20 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications  
21 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax  
22 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective  
23 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null  
24 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are

1 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time  
2 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
4 follows:

5 1. Round and Square Dance License Plates - such plates shall be  
6 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
7 round and square dancing;

8 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People  
9 License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to the  
10 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and  
11 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

12 3. National Rifle Association License Plates - such plates  
13 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the  
14 Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any  
15 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle  
16 Association;

17 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plates - such plates shall be  
18 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of  
19 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a  
20 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic  
22 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for  
23 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the  
24 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall  
2 contain the Masonic emblem;

3 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License  
4 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for  
5 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be  
6 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's  
7 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in  
8 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall  
9 contain the Shriner's emblem;

10 6. Balloonists License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
12 hot air ballooning in this state;

13 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall  
14 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member  
15 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an  
16 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a  
17 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an  
18 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an  
19 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate  
20 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate  
21 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star  
22 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

23 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be  
24 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of

1 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of  
2 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus  
4 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights  
5 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the  
6 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation  
7 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of  
8 Columbus emblem;

9 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and  
10 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license  
11 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license  
12 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

13 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be  
14 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying  
15 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag  
16 membership in Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed  
17 in consultation with Ducks Unlimited;

18 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be  
19 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons  
20 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in  
21 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in  
22 consultation with Kiwanis International;

23 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates  
24 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a

1 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified  
2 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
3 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a  
4 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed  
5 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public  
6 Accountants;

7 13. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates  
8 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate  
9 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons  
10 applying for such license plate must show proof of official  
11 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,  
12 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or  
13 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state  
14 emergency management department head;

15 14. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates  
16 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
17 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and  
18 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian  
19 Conservation Corps;

20 15. Rotarian License Plates - such plates shall be designed and  
21 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian  
22 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license  
23 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton  
24 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the

1 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate  
2 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license  
3 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian  
4 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

5 16. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plates - such  
6 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the  
7 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and  
8 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the  
9 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

10 17. Humane Society License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
12 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued  
13 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to  
14 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate  
15 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

16 18. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,  
18 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this  
19 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons  
20 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon  
21 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.  
22 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of  
23 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
24 personalized license plates;

1 19. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plates - such  
2 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business  
3 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of  
4 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in  
5 consultation with American Business Clubs;

6 20. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plates - such plates  
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate  
8 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States  
9 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall  
10 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central  
11 Oklahoma;

12 21. Oklahoma Aquarium License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
13 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
14 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in  
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

16 22. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plates - such plates  
17 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
18 support for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates  
19 shall be designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public  
20 School System;

21 23. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plates - such  
22 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of  
23 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the  
24 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

1 24. Parrothead Club License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead  
3 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any  
4 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as  
5 for personalized license plates;

6 25. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plates - such plates  
7 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the  
8 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed  
9 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

10 26. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be  
11 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
12 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed  
13 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's  
14 Association;

15 27. Alpha Kappa Alpha License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
16 be designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa  
17 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in  
18 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha  
19 Sorority;

20 28. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License  
21 ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any  
22 person wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities  
23 and fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council  
24 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation

1 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council  
2 Incorporated;

3 29. Organ, Eye and Tissue License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
4 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate  
5 support and increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation.  
6 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the State  
7 Department of Health;

8 30. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License ~~Plate~~ Plates  
9 - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to  
10 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.  
11 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central  
12 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

13 31. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated  
14 License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to  
15 persons wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and  
16 Community Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall  
17 be designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders  
18 of America Incorporated;

19 32. Delta Sigma Theta License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
20 be designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma  
21 Theta Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in  
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority  
23 Incorporated;

24

1        33. Omega Psi Phi License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi  
3 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
4 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Incorporated;

5        34. Alpha Phi Alpha License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
6 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha  
7 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
8 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity  
9 Incorporated;

10       35. 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System of Highways  
11 License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to  
12 persons wishing to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the  
13 Interstate System of Highways. The license plates shall be designed  
14 in consultation with the American Association of State Highway and  
15 Transportation Officials;

16       36. Kappa Alpha Psi License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi  
18 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
19 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity  
20 Incorporated;

21       37. Sigma Gamma Rho License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
22 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Sigma Gamma Rho  
23 Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with  
24 the Oklahoma Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Incorporated.

1 Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Sigma  
2 Gamma Rho License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,  
3 2013;

4 38. Multiple Sclerosis License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
5 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
6 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates  
7 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the  
8 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

9 39. Frederick Douglass High School License Plates - such plates  
10 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
11 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.  
12 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of  
13 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

14 40. United States Air Force Academy License Plates - such  
15 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
16 demonstrate support for the United States Air Force Academy;

17 41. In God We Trust License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
18 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be  
19 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

20 42. National Weather Center License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
21 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
22 support for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall  
23 be designed in consultation with representatives of the National  
24 Weather Center Directors;

1           43. Make-A-Wish Foundation License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
2 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate  
3 support for the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be  
4 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National  
5 Make-A-Wish Foundation;

6           44. South Central Section PGA Foundation License ~~Plate~~ Plates -  
7 such plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to  
8 demonstrate support for the South Central Section PGA Foundation.

13 School License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,

17 support for Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The  
18 plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the  
19 Northeast High School Alumni Association;

20           51.   Oklahoma City Central High School License ~~Plate~~ Plates -  
21 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
22 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni  
23 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with

2 Association;

3 52. Historic Greenwood District License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such  
4 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for

7 57. Don't Tread On Me License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
8 be designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem  
9 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden  
10 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
11 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

12 58. Oklahomans for the Arts License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
14 support for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts  
15 education. The plates shall be designed in consultation with  
16 Oklahomans for the Arts;

17 59. Oklahoma City Barons License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
19 support for the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be  
20 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization.  
21 The license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination  
22 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

23 60. Oklahoma City Redhawks License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
24 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

1 support for the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be  
2 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks  
3 organization;

5 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

3 66. Oklahoma Current State Flag License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such  
4 plates shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag  
5 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the  
6 current Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in  
7 consultation with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

8 67. Oklahoma Original State Flag License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such  
9 plates shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag  
10 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the  
11 original Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in  
12 consultation with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

13 68. Tulsa 66ers License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
14 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
15 the Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with  
16 the Tulsa 66ers Organization;

17 69. Jenks Trojans License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
18 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for Jenks School  
19 District and shall be designed in consultation with representatives  
20 of the Jenks School District; ~~and~~

21 70. Frederick Bombers License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
22 be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the  
23 Frederick School District and shall be designed in consultation with  
24 representatives of the Frederick School District; and

1        71. Sepsis Awareness License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness of  
3 sepsis. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with  
4 sepsis survivors.

5        C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)  
6 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by  
7 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise  
8 provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows:  
9 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be  
10 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be  
11 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
12 Registration Act and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the  
13 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in  
14 Section 1104 of this title.

15        SECTION 2.        AMENDATORY        47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as  
16 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.  
17 2015, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

18        Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
19 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
20 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide  
21 financial assistance as provided by this section.

22        Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
23 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
24 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
2 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
4 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
5 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
6 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
7 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
8 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
9 issued on a staggered system.

10 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
11 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
12 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
13 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
14 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
15 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
16 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
17 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
18 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
19 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
20 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
21 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

22 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
23 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
24 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of

1 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
2 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license  
3 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
4 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
5 removed from the vehicle.

6 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,  
7 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax  
8 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid  
9 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by  
10 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the  
11 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall  
12 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are  
13 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time  
14 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

15 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
16 follows:

17 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates  
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
19 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As  
20 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
21 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

22 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall  
23 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
24 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in

1 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
2 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide  
3 general public environmental education program created pursuant to  
4 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such  
5 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination  
6 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
7 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued  
8 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated  
9 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee  
10 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by  
11 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in  
12 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned  
13 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

14 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
15 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.  
16 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four  
17 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a  
18 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an  
19 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.  
20 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
21 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
22 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any  
23 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may  
24 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated

1 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon  
2 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire  
3 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief  
4 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in  
5 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

6 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
7 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &  
8 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and  
9 the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living Memorial;

10 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
12 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in  
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
14 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in  
15 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in  
16 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may  
17 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license  
18 plates.

19 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
20 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of  
21 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

22 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be  
23 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
24 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State

1 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child  
2 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
3 the prevention of child abuse.

4 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
5 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

6 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -  
7 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
8 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The  
9 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers  
10 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized  
11 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States  
12 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if  
13 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United  
14 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be  
15 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or  
16 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not  
17 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate  
18 issued;

19 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be  
20 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in  
21 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
22 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society  
23 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

1 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother  
3 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
4 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving  
5 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,  
6 Oklahoma;

7 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be  
8 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of  
9 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal  
10 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided  
11 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited  
12 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in  
13 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates  
15 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency  
16 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical  
17 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical  
19 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in  
20 consultation with the state association of emergency medical  
21 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
22 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical ~~Technician~~  
23 Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2  
24 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of  
3 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount  
4 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act  
5 Revolving Fund;

6 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall  
7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
8 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates  
9 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims  
10 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
11 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for  
12 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use  
13 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to  
14 provide services to crime victims;

15 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates  
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
17 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The  
18 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma

3 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in  
4 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to  
5 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in  
6 Section 1104.4 of this title;

7 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall  
8 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
9 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and  
10 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued  
11 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag  
12 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an  
13 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in  
14 Section 1104.3 of this title;

15 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates  
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate  
17 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The  
18 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
19 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As  
20 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
21 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial  
22 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of  
23 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

24

1        17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
3 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the  
4 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to  
5 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license  
6 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate  
7 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three  
8 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as  
9 follows:

- 10            a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education  
11                      Reform Revolving Fund,
- 12            b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher  
13                      Education Revolving Fund,
- 14            c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State  
15                      Career Technology Fund, and
- 16            d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be

6 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate  
7 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in  
8 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or  
9 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.  
10 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
11 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
12 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any  
13 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the  
14 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is  
15 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired

17 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the  
18 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

19       19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such  
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
21 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall  
22 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters  
23 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.  
24 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.

1 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into  
2 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any  
3 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts  
4 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide  
5 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty  
6 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such  
8 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the  
9 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and  
10 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state  
11 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and  
12 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
13 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of  
14 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5  
15 of this title;

16 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates  
17 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
18 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and  
19 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma  
20 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee  
21 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation  
22 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and  
23 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

24

1        22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates  
2 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of  
3 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for  
4 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive  
5 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and  
6 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates  
7 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation  
8 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human  
9 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall  
10 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury  
11 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the  
12 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act  
13 specifically for created families;

14        23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,

5 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed

10 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation

6 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain  
7 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The  
8 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a

7 deployed on active duty. The plates shall be issued to any person  
8 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of  
9 seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided in this  
10 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the  
11 Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of  
12 this title;

13 33. Global War on Terrorism License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such ~~plate~~  
14 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Military  
15 Department of Oklahoma and issued to any person wishing to  
16 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are members of the  
17 Armed Forces of the United States or Oklahoma National Guard that

12 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
13 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
14 Services for approval and payment.

15 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
