By deleting existing subsection "D" and by inserting in lieu thereof the following language:

"D. Any entity exercising control of public property on which an item, structure or area described in subsection A of this section is located may petition the Oklahoma Historical Society for a waiver to this section. A petition for waiver shall be in writing and shall state the reason or reasons upon which the waiver is sought. Any petition for waiver must be preceded by notice of intent by the entity, filed with the court clerk of the respective county where the subject of the petition is located. After filing notice of intent, the governing entity must allow a minimum of ninety (90) days for public comment, and a minimum of two (2) public hearings within the jurisdiction of the governing entity, notice of hearings must be made at least thirty (30) days prior to the convening of such hearing, and shall have been published in print media, of general circulation, stating the date, time, and place, and describing the specific action to be proposed and the reasons for requesting the waiver. After conducting the minimum two (2) hearings, the governing entity may pursue a waiver of restrictions, it may do so at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Oklahoma Historical Society Board of Directors, the Board must schedule such action a minimum of thirty (30) days after such petition is presented to them. The Board may grant a petition for waiver, by a majority vote of the board members. Board members must be present at the meeting to vote. The Board may include reasonable conditions and instructions to ensure that any items, structures or areas are preserved to the greatest extent possible."
