8 An Act relating to emergency responders; creating the  
9 Oklahoma Incident Management Team Advisory Committee;  
10 setting duties and purpose; providing for membership;  
11 providing that members receive no compensation or  
12 travel reimbursement; providing for quorum; providing  
13 for naming of chair; providing for frequency of  
14 meetings; providing for codification; and providing  
15 an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-108.4 of Title 47, unless  
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. There is hereby created within the Oklahoma Department of  
21 Public Safety the Oklahoma Incident Management Team Advisory  
22 Committee. The purpose of the Committee shall be to:

23 1. Advise and assist the Commissioner in the development of  
24 setting of goals, objectives and priorities with respect to state-  
sponsored all-hazard emergency incident management team functions;

1           2. Advise and assist the Commissioner in establishing standards  
2 and credentialing guidelines for emergency incident management  
3 functions and responders within the Team Advisory Committee's scope  
4 of authority; and

5           3. Provide a forum for discussion of issues between the  
6 organizations within the Team Advisory Committee.

7           B. The Team Advisory Committee shall be composed of the  
8 following seven (7) members as follows:

9           1. The Commissioner of Health, or designee;

10          2. The Director of the Oklahoma Forestry Services, or designee;

11          3. The Commissioner of the Oklahoma Department of Public  
12 Safety, or designee;

13          4. The Director of the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security, or  
14 designee;

15          5. The Director of the Office of Emergency Management, or  
16 designee;

17          6. One member appointed by the Oklahoma Fire Chiefs Association  
18 to represent a statewide association of fire chiefs in this state;  
19 and

20          7. The Director of the Oklahoma State University Fire Safety  
21 Training, or designee.

22           In addition to the seven (7) members, membership may be expanded  
23 by a majority vote of the Committee.

1 C. The members of the Team Advisory Committee shall receive no  
2 compensation or travel reimbursement.

3 D. A majority of the Team Advisory Committee shall constitute a  
4 quorum to transact official business.

5 E. The members of the Team Advisory Committee may elect from  
6 among its membership a chair and vice chair to preside at all  
7 meetings.

8 F. The Committee shall meet within ninety (90) days after the  
9 effective date of this act and shall meet at least twice a year or  
10 more frequently at the discretion of the chair.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.

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
