7 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to public safety communication
9 system; creating the Land Mobile Radio Public Safety
10 Interoperability Cooperative; providing for
11 participants; providing for governance model;
12 providing for duties of Cooperative; providing for
13 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 35.6.2 of Title 62, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. In order to comply with Executive Orders and federal and
19 state statutory and regulatory requirements related to interoperable
20 public safety communications and to support the critical mission and
21 purposes of the agencies within the Oklahoma Safety and Security
22 Cabinet, the Transportation Cabinet and the Finance, Administration
23 and Information Technology Cabinet, there is hereby established the
24 Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Interoperability Cooperative. The
Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Interoperability Cooperative shall

1 be governed by a committee initially consisting of the Secretary of
2 Finance, Administration and Information Technology or designee, the
3 Secretary of Transportation or designee and the Secretary of the
4 Safety and Security Cabinet of designee. The Cooperative is
5 established to focus on unifying, stabilizing and enhancing the
6 infrastructure and capabilities for land mobile radio public safety
7 system communications for the State of Oklahoma and shall include
8 representatives of other public radio system boards or committees
9 along with future voting or non-voting public entity members as
10 deemed appropriate, nominated and agreed to by vote of the committee
11 members defined in this paragraph.

12 B. 1. In establishing and operating the Land Mobile Radio
13 Public Safety Interoperability Cooperative, the committee shall
14 collaborate with other public agencies, public entities and other
15 interested parties having public safety radio communications
16 requirements and resources.

17 2. The Cooperative shall establish an appropriate governance
18 model for determining priorities, leveraging state-owned or other
19 shared services and infrastructure, identifying existing and new
20 resources and directing new investments to facilitate reliable,
21 statewide and fully operational public safety radio communications
22 to serve the purposes described.

23 3. In support of the requirements of the Oklahoma Homeland
24 Security Act, the Oklahoma Information Services Act and the

1 Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act, the
2 Cooperative shall have the following duties:

- 3 a. enable cost savings to the State of Oklahoma through
4 unification and enhancement of current land mobile
5 radio public safety systems,
- 6 b. sustain existing interoperability of land mobile
7 public safety radio systems,
- 8 c. recommend standards and protocols for land mobile
9 radio public safety systems,
- 10 d. recommend standards to become P25 compliant and other
11 common radio interoperability standards, and
- 12 e. establish service metrics to ensure reliable land
13 mobile public safety services statewide in support of
14 state, local and first responders.

15 C. Actions, decisions and operation of the Land Mobile Radio
16 Public Safety Interoperability Cooperative shall be performed in
17 compliance with, in support of and secondary to all statutory
18 duties, requirements, responsibilities and authority provided to the
19 Office of Management and Enterprise Services and the Oklahoma Office
20 of Homeland Security; however, the resources and mechanisms
21 available to Cooperative members by ownership or through agreement
22 may be collectively utilized to carry out the provisions of this
23 statute.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
