10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Cosmetology and  
12 Barbering Act; amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.10,  
13 as last amended by Section 8, Chapter 260, O.S.L.  
14 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 199.10), which  
15 relates to licenses; prohibiting display of certain  
16 personal information; providing for redaction of  
17 personal address information; providing an effective  
18 date; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.10, as  
20 last amended by Section 8, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp.  
21 2015, Section 199.10), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 199.10 A. All licenses issued under the provisions of  
23 the Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act shall be issued for a  
24 period of one (1) year. The expiration date of the license shall be

1 the last day of the month in which the applicant's birthday falls.  
2 The public display of a licensee's personal residential address on  
3 the face of any license issued pursuant to the provisions of the  
4 Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act shall be prohibited on and  
5 after July 1, 2016, and such personal address information, if  
6 publically displayed on a valid license, may be redacted by the  
7 licensee until the license is renewed and no longer bears his or her  
8 personal residential address.

9 B. Applications for renewal must be made on or before the last  
10 day of the month in which the applicant's birthday falls, and shall  
11 be accompanied by the appropriate fees.

12 C. Any person who fails to renew the license within the  
13 required time may make application for renewal at any time within  
14 five (5) years from the expiration date of the license by paying the  
15 regular renewal license fee and a late fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00),  
16 which becomes due two (2) months after the expiration date.

17 D. Any person who fails to renew within the required time may  
18 make application with subsequent renewal and penalty fees.

19 E. Before a person may take an examination to renew an expired  
20 license after a period of five (5) years, such person shall register  
21 in a cosmetology or barber school for the given number of review  
22 hours in accordance with the following timetable and schedule based  
23 upon the type of license held.

18 F. Each person holding a license shall notify the Board of any  
19 change in the mailing address of such person within thirty (30) days  
20 after any change.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
