10 An Act relating to state officers; amending 74 O.S.
11 2011, Section 250.4, as amended by Section 3 of
12 Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1096 of the 2nd
13 Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature (74 O.S.
14 Supp. 2014, Section 250.4), which relates to
statewide elected officers; modifying salaries; and
providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 250.4, as
17 amended by Section 3 of Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1096 of
18 the 2nd Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature (74 O.S. Supp.
19 2014, Section 250.4), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 250.4 Pursuant to provisions of the Constitution of the
21 State of Oklahoma from and after the beginning date of a term of
22 office which commences in, or after, ~~January 1999~~ January of 2016,
23 the following officers of the State of Oklahoma shall be annually
24 compensated for their services, payable monthly, as follows:

1 1. The Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the salary~~
2 ~~received by the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court;~~
3 ~~provided however, the Governor shall not receive any increase in~~
4 ~~salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution~~
5 ~~of One Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$147,000.00);~~

6 2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
7 ~~salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a~~
8 ~~population greater than ten thousand (10,000) and less than thirty~~
9 ~~thousand (30,000); provided however, the Lieutenant Governor shall~~
10 ~~not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of~~
11 ~~Section 1 of this resolution~~ of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven
12 Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);

13 3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
14 ~~salary received by the Presiding Judge of the Court of Civil~~
15 ~~Appeals; provided however, the Attorney General shall not receive~~
16 ~~any increase in salary as a result of Section 1 of this resolution~~
17 ~~of One Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-five Dollars~~
18 ~~(\$132,825.00);~~

19 4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive
20 a salary ~~equal to the salary received by a district judge; provided~~
21 ~~however, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall not~~
22 ~~receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of~~
23 ~~Section 1 of this resolution~~ of One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand
24 Three Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$124,373.00);

1 5. Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a
2 salary ~~equal to the salary received by an associate district judge~~
3 ~~in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000);~~
4 ~~provided however, the Commissioners shall not receive any increase~~
5 ~~in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this~~
6 ~~resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen~~
7 ~~Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

8 6. The State Treasurer shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
9 ~~salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a~~
10 ~~population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the~~
11 ~~State Treasurer shall not receive any increase in salary as a result~~
12 ~~of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred~~
13 ~~Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

14 7. The State Auditor and Inspector shall receive a salary ~~equal~~
15 ~~to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county~~
16 ~~with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided~~
17 ~~however, the State Auditor and Inspector shall not receive any~~
18 ~~increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of~~
19 ~~this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred~~
20 ~~Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

21 8. The State Insurance Commissioner shall receive a salary
22 ~~equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a~~
23 ~~county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided~~
24 ~~however, the State Insurance Commissioner shall not receive any~~

1 ~~increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of~~
2 ~~this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred~~
3 ~~Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00); and~~

4 9. The Commissioner of Labor shall receive a salary equal to
5 ~~the salary received by a special judge; provided however, the~~
6 ~~Commissioner of Labor shall not receive any increase in salary as a~~
7 ~~result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One~~
8 ~~Hundred Five Thousand Fifty-three Dollars (\$105,053.00).~~

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with
10 the provisions of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma
11 Constitution.
