12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 13 O.S. 2011, Section 176.7, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 176.7 The Attorney General, upon application by a  
16 district attorney, may make application to a judge of competent  
17 jurisdiction for, and such judge may grant in conformity with the  
18 Security of Communications Act, an order authorizing the  
19 interception of wire, oral or electronic communications by any law  
20 enforcement agency of this state or any political subdivision  
21 thereof having responsibility for the investigation of the offense  
22 as to which the application is made, when such interception may  
23 provide evidence of acts of biochemical terrorism, terrorism,  
24 terrorism hoax, and biochemical assault, as defined in Section
