7 An Act relating to children and juvenile code;
8 amending 10A O.S. 2011, Section 1-2-108, which
9 relates to the central registry for child abuse
reports; providing for the inclusion of certain
reports; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10A O.S. 2011, Section 1-2-108, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1-2-108. A. There is hereby established within the
16 Department of Human Services an information system for the
17 maintenance of all reports of child abuse, sexual abuse, sexual
18 exploitation, and neglect made pursuant to the provisions of the
19 Oklahoma Children's Code.

20 B. The Children and Family Services Division of the Department
21 shall be responsible for maintaining a suitably cross-indexed system
22 of all the reports.

23 C. The records maintained shall contain, but shall not be
24 limited to:

1 1. All information in the written report required by Section 1-
2 2-101 of this title;

3 2. A record of the final disposition of the report including
4 services offered and services accepted;

5 3. The plan for rehabilitative treatment; and

6 4. Any other relevant information.

7 D. Data and information maintained and related to individual
8 cases shall be confidential and shall be made available only as
9 authorized by state or federal law.

10 E. The Commission for Human Services shall promulgate rules
11 governing the availability of such data and information.

12 F. Rules promulgated by the Commission shall encourage
13 cooperation with other states in exchanging reports in order to
14 effect a national registration system.

15 G. No person shall allow the data and information maintained to
16 be released except as authorized by Chapter VI of the Oklahoma
17 Children's Code.

18 H. Records obtained by the Department shall be maintained by
19 the Department until otherwise provided by law.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
