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7 An Act relating to technology; establishing the
8 Criminal Justice Information Systems Center for
9 Excellence; stating purpose; stating administrative
10 control; authorizing collaboration with agencies;
11 allowing utilization of system for certain purposes;
12 providing for codification; and providing an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 35.6.1 of Title 62, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. In order to comply with Executive Orders and federal and
19 state statutory and regulatory requirements related to the criminal
20 justice information system, to support agencies within the Oklahoma
21 Safety and Security Cabinet, and to accomplish the purposes of the
22 Information Services Division of the Office of Management and
23 Enterprise Services, there is hereby established the "Criminal
24 Justice Information Systems Center for Excellence" to provide shared
infrastructure services for such agencies. The Criminal Justice

1 Information Systems Center for Excellence shall be under the
2 administrative control of the Chief Information Officer.

3 B. In establishing and operating the Criminal Justice
4 Information Systems Center for Excellence through the Information
5 Services Division, the Chief Information Officer shall collaborate
6 with agencies subject to criminal justice information system
7 requirements. The Chief Information Officer, in conjunction with
8 the Commissioner of Public Safety, shall establish an appropriate
9 governance model for priorities, shared services and systems for the
10 Criminal Justice Information Systems Center for Excellence. The
11 Chief Information Officer may utilize the Criminal Justice
12 Information Systems Center for Excellence to accomplish such other
13 purposes as may be necessary for the administration of the duties of
14 the Information Services Division that are related to stringent
15 federal or state data security requirements, provided the security
16 of investigative and law enforcement information and support systems
17 is not jeopardized.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
