7 An Act relating to roads and bridges; amending 69
8 O.S. 2011, Section 1698.25, which relates to the
9 Kelly Downing Memorial Highway; modifying memorial
10 highway name; requiring certain reference be made on
11 certain permanent markers; amending 69 O.S. 2011,
12 Section 1698.62, which relates to the Veterans
13 Memorial Highway; modifying designation of certain
14 highway; requiring placement of certain highway
15 markers; designating the President Dwight D.
16 Eisenhower Memorial Highway; designating the Cullison
17 Memorial Highway; designating the Dr. Herbert Rowland
18 Memorial Bridge; designating the 1st Lt Robert E.
19 Trigalet, USMC Memorial Highway; designating the Army
20 T/Sgt. Yancy B. Kite, KIA WWII, Memorial Highway;
21 designating the Air Force TSgt Eugene S. Bell, MD,
22 POW WWII, Memorial Bridge; designating the MSG Joshua
23 Wheeler, U.S. Army Delta Force, Memorial Highway;
24 designating the J.R. Proctor Memorial Highway;
designating the United States Submarine Veterans
Memorial Highway; designating the Army PVT Paul
Gilbert, KIA WWII, Memorial Highway; designating the
CW2 Randy Lee Billings Memorial Highway; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1698.25, is
23 amended to read as follows:
24

1 Section 1698.25 The section of State Highway 251A in Wagoner
2 County extending from the junction of State Highway 251A and State
3 Highway 16 east to Cherokee County shall be designated as the "Cpl
4 Kelly Downing, USMC, Memorial Highway". The Department of
5 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
6 on the highway bearing that name. The Department shall make
7 reference on the permanent markers that Cpl Kelly Downing, USMC, was
8 awarded the Silver Star Medal.

9 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1698.62, is
10 amended to read as follows:

11 Section 1698.62 ~~The~~ A. Except as provided in subsection B of
12 this section, the portion of ~~State~~ U.S. Highway 62 beginning and
13 ending with the city limits of Blanchard shall be designated as the
14 "Veterans Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
15 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
16 bearing that name.

17 B. The portion of U.S. Highway 62 in Blanchard extending
18 northeast from the intersection with State Highway 76 to the
19 intersection with State Highway 9 shall be designated as the "SFC
20 Tony K. Burris Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
21 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
22 bearing that name.

1 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.231 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The portion of U.S. Highway 81 beginning at the junction of U.S.
5 Highway 81 and 192nd Street NE in Canadian County extending south to
6 the junction of U.S. Highway 81 and Memorial Road in Canadian County
7 shall be designated as the "President Dwight D. Eisenhower Memorial
8 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
9 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.232 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The portion of State Highway 11 beginning at the junction of
14 State Highway 11 and East 36th Street North in Tulsa County
15 extending north to the junction of State Highway 11 and East 96th
16 Street North in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "Cullison
17 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
18 suitable markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.233 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge crossing the Kiamichi River on State Highway 271
23 north of Antlers shall be designated as the "Dr. Herbert Rowland
24 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause

1 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that
2 name.

3 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.234 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The portion of State Highway 16 beginning at the junction of
7 State Highway 16 and State Highway 48 in Creek County extending east
8 to the junction of State Highway 16 and S 329th W Avenue in Creek
9 County shall be designated as the "1st Lt Robert E. Trigalet, USMC
10 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
11 suitable markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

12 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.235 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of State Highway 78 in Johnston County beginning at
16 the junction of State Highway 78 and County Road N3590 extending
17 east to the western city limits of Milburn shall be designated as
18 the "Army T/Sgt. Yancy B. Kite, KIA WWII, Memorial Highway". The
19 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing
20 that name to be placed on the highway.

21 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.236 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24

1 The bridge crossing the Washita River in Johnston County on
2 State Highway 99 shall be designated as the "Air Force TSgt Eugene
3 S. Bell, MD, POW WWII, Memorial Bridge". The Department of
4 Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be
5 placed on the bridge.

6 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.237 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The portion of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the junction of U.S.
10 Highway 64 and State Highway 64B in Sequoyah County extending east
11 to the junction of U.S. Highway 64 and County Road N4760 in Sequoyah
12 County shall be designated as the "MSG Joshua Wheeler, U.S. Army
13 Delta Force, Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
14 shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be placed on the
15 highway.

16 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.238 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The portion of State Highway 20 in Collinsville beginning at the
20 junction of State Highway 20 and U.S. Highway 169 extending west to
21 the junction of State Highway 20 and 5th Street shall be designated
22 as the "J.R. Proctor Memorial Highway". The Department of
23 Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be
24 placed on the highway.

1 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.239 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The portion of State Highway 20 in Owasso beginning at the
5 junction of State Highway 20 and 145th E Avenue extending west to
6 the junction of State Highway 20 and U.S. Highway 169 shall be
7 designated as the "United States Submarine Veterans Memorial
8 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
9 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.240 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:40

13 The section of U.S. Highway 377 in Johnston County beginning at
14 the northern most junction with State Highway 7 in Johnston County
15 extending north to the Johnston County line shall be designated as
16 the "Army PVT Paul Gilbert, KIA WWII, Memorial Highway". The
17 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing
18 that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.241 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The portion of U.S. Highway 59 Bypass beginning at the junction
23 of U.S Highway 59 Bypass and U.S. Highway 59 extending south to the
24 intersection of U.S. Highway 59 Bypass and E Pleasant Valley Road

1 shall be designated as the "CW2 Randy Lee Billings Memorial
2 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
3 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

4 SECTION 14. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
