7 An Act relating to elections; creating the Military  
8 Privacy Protection Act; amending 26 O.S. 2011,  
9 Section 4-115.2, which relates to address  
10 confidentiality; adding military to protected class  
11 status; providing for noncodification; and providing  
12 an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Military  
17 Privacy Protection Act".

18 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-115.2, is  
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 4-115.2 The Secretary of the State Election Board is  
21 authorized to promulgate rules to keep confidential the residence  
22 and mailing address, upon application to do so, of individual  
23 registered voters who are members of certain classes. These classes  
24 shall be limited to the judiciary, district attorneys, assistant  
district attorneys, Uniformed Services members, law enforcement

1 personnel, correctional officers, persons who are protected by  
2 victim's protection orders, the spouses and dependents of the  
3 members of such classes, and persons who are certified by the  
4 Secretary of State as participants in the Address Confidentiality  
5 Program established by Section 60.14 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma  
6 Statutes. Such address information shall be provided to a candidate  
7 or candidate representative or other lawful authority in  
8 anticipation or as part of a contest of candidacy or contest of an  
9 election as provided for in Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes or as  
10 part of a petition challenge as provided by law. However, no  
11 information concerning the address of a certified Address  
12 Confidentiality Program participant shall be released by election  
13 officials to any person for any purpose except under court order.

14 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
