6 An Act relating to municipalities; amending 11 O.S.  
7 2011, Section 22-116, which relates to jurisdiction  
8 over real property and navigable streams; removing  
9 population requirement for jurisdiction; authorizing  
10 municipalities to enter into cooperative agreements  
11 under certain circumstances; and providing an  
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 22-116, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 22-116. A. Except as provided for in subsection B of  
17 this section, the municipality shall have jurisdiction over any real  
18 property within or without its corporate limits belonging to the  
19 municipality.

20 B. ~~A The municipality with a population of more than three~~  
21 ~~hundred fifty thousand (350,000) persons, according to the most~~  
22 ~~recent Federal Decennial Census,~~ shall have jurisdiction over any  
23 real property within its corporate limits belonging to the  
24 municipality. The municipality shall have the authority to enact  
ordinances regulating real property belonging to the municipality

1 that is outside the corporate limits of the municipality. Municipal  
2 property outside the corporate limits of the municipality shall be  
3 subject to state or municipal law and any violation of state or  
4 municipal law shall be prosecuted in the district court of the  
5 county or the municipal court of the local city where the violation  
6 occurred. Unless otherwise provided for by law, the municipality  
7 may regulate the banks, shores, and wharves of navigable streams  
8 within the corporate limits. In the event of dual municipal  
9 jurisdiction, municipalities are authorized to enter into  
10 cooperative agreements defining and regulating the governing  
11 jurisdiction.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
