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7 An Act relating to parental rights; creating the  
8 Parental Rights Immunization Act; requiring health  
9 care provider to obtain informed consent from legal  
10 representative prior to vaccinating child; requiring  
health care provider to provide certain information;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2006 of Title 25, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Parental Rights  
18 Immunization Act".

19 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2007 of Title 25, unless there  
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 Each health care provider who administers a vaccine set forth in  
23 the Vaccine Injury Table, as established by the United States  
24 Department of Health and Human Services, shall obtain informed

1 consent from the legal representative or other adult authorized by  
2 law to consent on behalf of a minor of any child to whom such  
3 provider intends to administer such vaccine. Prior to administering  
4 the vaccine, the health care provider shall provide relevant  
5 information regarding benefits and risks of the vaccine as well as  
6 information concerning the National Vaccine Injury Compensation  
7 Program. Providing a copy of the Vaccine Information Statement, the  
8 source of which is clearly identified, and making available for  
9 review the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's  
10 "Epidemiology and Prevention of Vaccine-Preventable Diseases:  
11 Vaccine Excipient and Media Summary" (also known as the "Pink Book",  
12 Appendix B) to the legal representative or other adult authorized by  
13 law to consent on behalf of a minor shall constitute a minimum  
14 standard of relevant information.

15 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
