9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.9c of Title 36, unless  
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 Subject to the availability of funding, the Oklahoma Insurance  
14 Department shall analyze discrepancies between coverage for  
15 prescription drugs with abuse-deterrent properties and coverage for  
16 prescription opioids without abuse-deterrent properties. Such  
17 information shall be submitted in a report to the President Pro  
18 Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
19 Representatives on or before December 31, 2017.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.  
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
