6 An Act relating to county sheriffs; authorizing
7 sheriffs to charge fee for impounded vehicles;
8 requiring fee to be set annually, requiring
9 consultation with boards of county commissioners;
10 providing for deposit in certain account; providing
11 for codification; providing effective date; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 514.6 of Title 19, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 County sheriffs may impose a reasonable fee charged to the
18 record owner or owners of any vehicle subject to impoundment by the
19 sheriff's office. Such fee shall be set annually by the sheriff, in
20 consultation with the board of county commissioners, and shall
21 reasonably cover the cost of such impoundment. Fees assessed
22 pursuant to this act shall be deposited in the Sheriff's Service Fee
23 Account, pursuant to Section 514.1 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma
24 Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
