7 [ Oklahoma Viticulture and Enology Center Development  
8 Revolving Fund - Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,  
9 Food, and Forestry - noncodification - effective  
10 date]

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 37 O.S. 2011, Section 563.1, as  
13 amended by Section 127, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (37 O.S. Supp.  
14 2014, Section 563.1), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 563.1. A. There is hereby created in the State  
16 Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of ~~Commerce~~  
17 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to be designated the "Oklahoma  
18 Viticulture and Enology Center Development Revolving Fund".

19 B. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal  
20 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies distributed to the  
21 fund:

22 1. From the apportionment provided in paragraph 1 of Section  
23 563 of this title; and

1           2. From any other source in accordance with state and federal  
2 law.

3           C. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby  
4 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for  
5 the purpose of:

6           1. Establishing a Viticulture and Enology Center on the campus  
7 of Redlands Community College;

8           2. Developing viticulture-related and enology-related education  
9 programs;

10          3. Developing technologies, strategies, or practices that aid  
11 in the production of grapes and wine in Oklahoma; and

12          4. Increasing the positive economic impact of the Oklahoma wine  
13 industry on this state.

14           D. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants  
15 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
16 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
17 Services for approval and payment.

18           SECTION 2.        NEW LAW        A new section of law not to be  
19 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

20           All funds currently held in the Oklahoma Viticulture and Enology  
21 Center Development Revolving Fund shall remain in the fund and be  
22 available for use by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food,  
23 and Forestry for the purposes identified in Section 1 of this act.

24           SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
