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6 An Act relating to state government; creating the  
7 Advisory Task Force on Efficiencies in State  
8 Financial Management; providing for membership,  
9 meetings, election of a chair, and staff support for  
10 task force; authorizing travel reimbursement pursuant  
11 to specified statutes; providing duty of task force;  
12 requiring report and providing for distribution  
13 thereof; requiring compliance with certain statutes;  
14 and providing for noncodification.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 A. There is hereby created a five-member Advisory Task Force on  
19 Efficiencies in State Financial Management. The membership of the  
20 task force shall be as follows:

- 21 1. The State Treasurer or a designee;
- 22 2. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
23 Services or a designee;
- 24 3. The State Comptroller or a designee;
4. One member appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the  
Senate; and

1           5. One member appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
2 Representatives.

3           B. The State Treasurer shall call the first meeting of the task  
4 force by September 1, 2015. At the first meeting, the members of  
5 the task force shall elect a chair. A majority of the members of  
6 the task force shall constitute a quorum to transact business. The  
7 Senate and House shall provide such staff support as is required by  
8 the Task Force.

9           C. Members of the Advisory Task Force on Efficiencies in State  
10 Financial Management shall receive no compensation for serving on  
11 the task force, but shall receive travel reimbursement as follows:

12           1. Legislative members shall be reimbursed for necessary travel  
13 expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance  
14 with Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

15           2. Non-legislative members shall be reimbursed by their  
16 respective appointing authorities for necessary travel expenses  
17 incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with the  
18 State Travel Reimbursement Act.

19           D. It shall be the duty of the Advisory Task Force on  
20 Efficiencies in State Financial Management to review:

21           1. All comprehensive financial and accounting functions  
22 performed by any state agency which provides financial, accounting  
23 or business services to other state agencies or for the state;  
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
