1 "SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-609, as
2 amended by Section 2, Chapter 28, O.S.L. 2012 (2 O.S. Supp. 2014,
3 Section 6-609), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 6-609. A. ~~The State Board of Agriculture shall~~
5 ~~promulgate rules for the testing and intrastate movement of live~~
6 ~~feral swine.~~

7 B. All persons that transport live feral swine in this state
8 shall be required to obtain a transporter license from the Oklahoma
9 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry. Prior to
10 transporting captured feral swine, the capturer shall tag the swine
11 using a Department-approved identification method and have all
12 captured feral swine test negative to a pseudorabies and brucellosis
13 test administered by a state-licensed veterinarian, as well as any
14 other diseases as required by the Department.

15 ~~C.~~ B. Live feral swine shall only be transported to the
16 following:

- 17 1. A licensed sporting facility;
- 18 2. A licensed handling facility;
- 19 3. Directly to an approved slaughter facility; or
- 20 4. Pursuant to an order issued by the State Veterinarian.

21 C. No person shall commingle feral swine with domestic swine at
22 any time. No person shall hold feral swine on any premises where
23 domestic swine are located.

1 D. No person shall hold feral swine at a licensed handling
2 facility for more than thirty (30) consecutive days unless the feral
3 swine are held solely for domestic consumption purposes. No person
4 shall allow breeding of feral swine held for domestic consumption
5 purposes.

6 E. Any person adding feral swine to a licensed sporting
7 facility shall ensure each feral swine is individually identified
8 with a form of official identification and tests negative to a
9 pseudorabies and brucellosis test administered by a state-licensed
10 veterinarian within ten (10) days prior to entry into the licensed
11 sporting facility."
