On page 2, lines 5 through 11, by deleting all of the new language;

On page 7, line 15, by adding after the word "commissioners" and before the semicolon ";", the following language:

". The county may designate two individuals who are not county employees for each entity to act as receiving officers for fire protection districts, senior citizens' centers and other entities within the county. A written designation of these individuals shall be filed with the county clerk and shall be entered in the minutes of the board of county commissioners. Further, entities choosing to designate any nonemployee of the county to act as a receiving officer shall provide evidence of blanket bond coverage or employee dishonesty liability insurance for any such designee"

On pages 8 and 9, by deleting all of subsection C;

And on page 9, line 7 1/2, by inserting a new section 2 to read as follows:

And renumbering subsequent sections.

1 "SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 1503, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 1503. A. Each county officer shall designate two ~~(2)~~  
4 employees to act as receiving officers for their departments. A  
5 written designation of such employees shall be filed with the county  
6 clerk and shall be entered in the minutes of the board of county  
7 commissioners.

8 B. The county may designate two individuals who are not county  
9 employees for each entity to act as receiving officers for fire  
10 protection districts, senior citizen centers and other entities  
11 within the county. A written designation of these individuals shall  
12 be filed with the county clerk and shall be entered in the minutes  
13 of the board of county commissioners. Further, entities choosing to  
14 designate any nonemployee of the county to act as a receiving  
15 officer shall provide evidence of blanket bond coverage or employee  
16 dishonesty liability insurance for any such designee."
