MR. SPEAKER: I move that the CCR for Senate Bill 383 be rejected and that further conference be requested with the following instructions:

Page 33 Section 7 Line 11

By inserting after the word "minors" and before the period "." the following language:

"; provided, such education include but not be limited to training courses and materials for mandatory responsible alcoholic beverage service and sales training programs designated by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission in consultation with the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services";

Page 49 Section 13 Line 2 1/2

By inserting a Subsection H to read as follows:

"H. Every person or entity that makes application for any license or renewal of any valid license issued by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission for the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption or off-premises consumption, shall certify that employees who, as part of their employment responsibilities, sell, prepare, dispense, serve or otherwise deliver alcoholic beverages directly to patrons of the licensed establishment, whether for on-premises or off-premises consumption, or who manage employees with such responsibilities, have successfully completed a responsible alcoholic beverage service and sales training program designated by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission in consultation with the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.";

By inserting a Subsection G to read as follows:

"G. 1. Prior to the end of calendar year 2018 and prior to the end of each calendar year thereafter, until the provisions of paragraph 3 of this subsection become operative, the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission shall determine for the year the:

a. rate of sales of alcoholic beverages to individuals under 21 years of age in the state,

b. rate of alcohol-related crashes in the state,

c. rate of alcohol-related traffic fatalities in the state resulting from the presence of blood alcohol levels in excess of 0.01, and

d. rate of unintentional alcohol poisoning deaths in the state.

2. The determinations made for calendar year 2018 shall serve as the baseline for comparison for subsequent calendar year determinations. Each calendar year beginning with year 2019, the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission shall compare such year's determinations to the baseline determinations.

3. a. Upon a determination by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission that the determinations made for a calendar year as required by subparagraph a of paragraph 1 of this subsection are less favorable than the baseline determination, the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission shall prohibit the sale of alcoholic beverages, containing more than three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) alcohol by weight, by persons under twenty-one (21) years of age:

b. Upon a determination by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission that the determinations made for a calendar year as required by subparagraphs b, c, or d of paragraph 1 of this subsection are less favorable than the baseline determinations, the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission shall prohibit the sale of cold alcoholic beverages, containing more than three and two-tenths percent (3.2%) alcohol by weight, for off-premises consumption."
