1 "SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-609, as
2 amended by Section 2, Chapter 28, O.S.L. 2012 (2 O.S. Supp. 2015,
3 Section 6-609), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 6-609. A. The State Board of Agriculture shall
5 promulgate rules for the testing and intrastate movement of live
6 feral swine.

7 B. All persons that transport live feral swine in this state
8 shall be required to obtain a transporter license from the Oklahoma
9 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry.

10 C. Live feral swine shall only be transported to the following:

- 11 1. A licensed sporting facility;
- 12 2. A licensed handling facility;
- 13 3. Directly to an approved slaughter facility; or
- 14 4. Pursuant to an order issued by the State Veterinarian.

15 D. All land within the state north of Interstate 40 and west of
16 Interstate 35 shall be a feral-swine-free zone.

17 E. Transportation of live feral swine into, through or within a
18 feral-swine-free zone is prohibited.

19 F. Transporting live feral swine out of a feral-swine-free zone
20 shall be allowed subject to rules promulgated by the State Board of
21 Agriculture.

22 G. Feral swine facilities are prohibited within any feral-
23 swine-free zone. Licenses for feral swine facilities existing
24

1 within any feral-swine-free zone established by the State Board of
2 Agriculture shall not be renewed.

3 H. Any person may hunt or capture feral swine within a feral-
4 swine-free zone pursuant to the provisions of the Feral Swine
5 Control Act. To assist the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,
6 Food, and Forestry with tracking and eliminating feral swine
7 populations, a person shall report any feral swine activity to the
8 Department, to include but not limited to any observation, capture
9 or killing of feral swine.

10 I. The State Board of Agriculture may employ private or public
11 entities to eradicate feral swine anywhere in the State of Oklahoma.

12 J. Any expansion or modification of the limits of a feral-
13 swine-free zone shall require legislative approval.

14 K. As used in this section "feral-swine-free zone" means the
15 region of the state described in subsection D of this section where
16 hunting feral swine or taking feral swine from the region is
17 restricted and the licensing of feral swine facilities or movement
18 of feral swine into or across the region is prohibited."
