11 An Act relating to memorial highway designations;
12 amending Section 4, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 2014 (69 O.S.
13 Supp. 2014, Section 1698.197), which relates to the
14 Fire Chief Nolan Schmidt Highway; modifying name and
15 end point of the highway designation; designating the
16 Weatherford Veterans Memorial Drive; designating the
17 President George H.W. Bush Highway; designating the
18 President George W. Bush Highway; designating the 49
19 Waiters Club Memorial Bridge; designating the SSG
20 Travis Tompkins Memorial Highway; designating the SPC
21 Charles Jirtle Memorial Highway; designating the 1st
22 Lt. Brandon Landrum Memorial Highway; designating the
23 PFC Ernest Ray Taylor Memorial Bridge; designating
24 the PFC Jon Ross Townsend Memorial Highway;
 designating the SSG James "Bevo" Olivo Memorial
 Bridge; designating the Bill Milroy Memorial Bridge;
 designating the Trooper Nicholas Dees Memorial
 Highway; providing for codification; and providing an
 effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 268, O.S.L.
2 2014 (69 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 1698.197), is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 Section 1698.197 The portion of State Highway 58 between the
5 junction of State Highway 58 and Interstate 40 extending north to
6 the junction of State Highway 58 and County Road ~~E980~~ N2450 shall be
7 designated as the "Fire Chief Nolan Schmidt Memorial Highway". The
8 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
9 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

10 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.213 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The portion of State Highway 54 from the junction of State
14 Highway 54 and County Road E1020 extending southeast to the junction
15 of State Highway 54 and 7th Street in Weatherford, Oklahoma, shall
16 be designated as the "Weatherford Veterans Memorial Drive". The
17 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
18 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.214 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The portion of U.S. Highway 81 from five-tenths (0.5) of a mile
23 north of the junction of U.S. Highway 81 and County Road E0760
24 extending north to five-tenths (0.5) of a mile south of the junction

1 of U.S. Highway 81 and County Road E0720 shall be designated as the
2 "President George H.W. Bush Highway". The Department of
3 Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be
4 placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.215 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The portion of U.S. Highway 81 from five-tenths (0.5) of a mile
9 north of the junction of U.S. Highway 81 and County Road E0700
10 extending north to five-tenths (0.5) of a mile south of the junction
11 of U.S. Highway 81 and County Road E0650 shall be designated as the
12 "President George W. Bush Highway". The Department of
13 Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be
14 placed on the highway.

15 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.216 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The bridge where U.S. 62 crosses the North Canadian River in
19 Oklahoma County shall be designated as the "49 Waiters Club Memorial
20 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
21 permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

22 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.217 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 65 beginning at the intersection of
2 State Highway 7 in Comanche County and extending northward two (2)
3 miles shall be designated as the "SSG Travis Tompkins Memorial
4 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
5 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

6 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.218 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The section of State Highway 65 beginning at the intersection of
10 State Highway 7 in Comanche County and extending southward two (2)
11 miles shall be designated as the "SPC Charles Jirtle Memorial
12 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
13 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

14 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.219 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The section of State Highway 65 beginning at the intersection of
18 NE Cache Road in Comanche County and extending northward and
19 eastward for a total of two (2) miles shall be designated as the
20 "1st Lt. Brandon Landrum Memorial Highway". The Department of
21 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
22 name to be placed on the highway.

1 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.220 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge located on State Highway 55 approximately two hundred
5 fifty (250) feet west of the municipal limits of Sentinel shall be
6 designated as the "PFC Ernest Ray Taylor Memorial Bridge". The
7 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
8 to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

9 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.221 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The Section of State Highway 88 in Rogers County, from the
13 junction of State Highway 88 and E 450 Road extending north to the
14 junction of State Highway 88 and E 440 Road shall be designated as
15 the "PFC Jon Ross Townsend Memorial Highway". The Department of
16 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
17 name to be placed on the highway.

18 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.222 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The bridge located on State Highway 270 in Hughes County
22 approximately five-tenths (0.5) of a mile west of the junction of
23 State Highway 270 and State Highway 48 shall be designated as the
24 "SSG James "Bevo" Olivo Memorial Bridge". The Department of

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
2 upon the bridge bearing that name.

3 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.223 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge located on State Highway 56 in Okmulgee County
7 approximately five-tenths (0.5) of a mile west of the junction of
8 State Highway 56 and S. Madison Avenue in Okmulgee shall be
9 designated as the "Bill Milroy Memorial Bridge". The Department of
10 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
11 upon the bridge bearing that name.

12 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.224 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of Interstate 40 from mile marker 190 in
16 Pottawatomie County to mile marker 200 in Seminole County shall be
17 designated as the "Trooper Nicholas Dees Memorial Highway". The
18 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
19 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

20 SECTION 14. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
