

1 person or entity claiming such an interest in real estate, or any
2 successor in interest, shall notify the county assessor of any
3 change to the mailing address. Such person or entity shall complete
4 and sign a change of address form at the county assessor's office or
5 mail a notarized form to the assessor's office. The form shall be
6 prescribed by the State Auditor and Inspector and the new mailing
7 address shall be substituted on all records of the county assessor
8 and the county treasurer. On and after the effective date of this
9 act, the only acceptable method to change such address on any such
10 county record is in compliance with this section. The filing of
11 such a mailing change of address shall not be construed as a change
12 of the legal or equitable ownership interest. The county assessor
13 shall maintain all such change of address forms or an electronic
14 version thereof. The most recent mailing address of record, whether
15 from the original instrument or the most recent change of address
16 form prescribed by this section, shall be relied upon by county
17 officials for any mailing notice requirements of any other statute.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
