



1 Section 2-105.4A. There is hereby created within the Oklahoma  
2 Highway Patrol Division the Size and Weight Enforcement Section.  
3 The Commissioner of Public Safety shall employ a minimum of twenty-  
4 five additional members of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, one Captain,  
5 ~~one First Lieutenant~~ and ~~three Second Lieutenant Supervisors~~ eight  
6 Lieutenants and shall assign the twenty-five members of the Oklahoma  
7 Highway Patrol, one Captain, ~~one First Lieutenant~~ and ~~three Second~~  
8 ~~Lieutenant Supervisors~~ eight Lieutenants to the Size and Weight  
9 Enforcement Section. The Size and Weight Enforcement Section shall  
10 have the primary duty of the enforcement of the provisions of  
11 Section 14-101 et seq. of this title.

12 Said Commissioner shall purchase and maintain the necessary  
13 motor vehicle equipment, portable scales and other items of  
14 equipment and supplies and shall provide proper training necessary  
15 for the enforcement of the provisions of Section 14-101 et seq. of  
16 this title.

17 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-105.6, is  
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 2-105.6. A. There is hereby created within the  
20 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety  
21 a Marine Enforcement Section which shall consist of such employees  
22 as may be necessary to enforce the provisions of Section 4001 et  
23 seq., Section 4101 et seq., and Section 4200 et seq. of Title 63 of  
24 the Oklahoma Statutes. All commissioned officers of the Marine

1 Enforcement Section as designated by the Commissioner shall have the  
2 authority to stop and board any vessel subject to Section 4001 et  
3 seq. of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes and make any necessary  
4 arrest for violations of Section 4001 et seq. of Title 63 of the  
5 Oklahoma Statutes or the rules promulgated by the Department of  
6 Public Safety or the Department of Wildlife Conservation or take any  
7 other action within their lawful authority. Any statutory  
8 references to the Oklahoma Lake Patrol Division or the Lake Patrol  
9 Section of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division shall mean the  
10 Marine Enforcement Section of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division  
11 of the Department of Public Safety.

12 B. All commissioned officers of the Marine Enforcement Section  
13 of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public  
14 Safety shall have, in addition to their primary duty as prescribed  
15 in subsection A of this section, a secondary duty to enforce all  
16 state statutes, to make arrests for violations and to perform other  
17 duties as prescribed by the Commissioner.

18 C. The annual salaries for the commissioned officers within the  
19 Marine Enforcement Section of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division  
20 of the Department of Public Safety shall be in accordance and  
21 conformity with ~~the following salary schedule, exclusive of~~  
22 ~~longevity pay, as authorized by Section 840-2.18 of Title 74 of the~~  
23 ~~Oklahoma Statutes, expense allowance, as authorized by Section 2-130~~

1 ~~of this title, and irregular shift pay, as authorized by Section 2-~~  
2 ~~130.1 of this title:~~

6 Section 2-105.4 of this title.

7 D. The provisions of this section shall supersede all existing  
8 laws covering the salaries for the commissioned officers in the  
9 Marine Enforcement Section of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division  
10 of the Department of Public Safety.

11 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-105.8, as  
12 amended by Section 3, Chapter 135, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp. 2014,  
13 Section 2-105.8), is amended to read as follows:

14 Section 2-105.8. A. There is hereby created within the  
15 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety,  
16 the Communications Section.

17 B. An employee ~~shall not~~ may be promoted to the position of  
18 Communications Coordinator.

19 C. The annual salaries of personnel comprising this section  
20 shall be in accordance and conformity with the findings for  
21 Department of Public Safety law enforcement personnel of the State  
22 of Oklahoma Total Remuneration Study of 2013.

23 D. The provisions of this section shall supersede all existing  
24 laws covering the salaries for the positions in the Communications

1 Section of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division of the Department of  
2 Public Safety.

3 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-106, as  
4 amended by Section 4, Chapter 135, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp. 2014,  
5 Section 2-106), is amended to read as follows:

6 Section 2-106. A. There is hereby established in the  
7 Department of Public Safety the Driver License ~~Examining~~ Services  
8 Division and the Driver Compliance Division and such other divisions  
9 as the Commissioner of Public Safety may direct.

10 B. The Driver License ~~Examining~~ Services Division shall consist  
11 of noncommissioned classified employees of the Department who may  
12 administer tests for the purpose of issuing driver licenses pursuant  
13 to Section 6-101 et seq. of this title.

14 C. Any employee appointed to the position of Driver License  
15 Examiner shall be not less than twenty-one (21) nor more than sixty-  
16 five (65) years of age and any person appointed to the position of  
17 Senior Driver License Examiner shall have held the position of  
18 Driver License Examiner with the Department for not less than three  
19 (3) years immediately preceding such appointment.

20 D. 1. Any person appointed to any position created pursuant to  
21 this section shall:

- 22 a. be a citizen of the State of Oklahoma,
  - 23 b. be of good moral character,
- 24

- 1 c. possess a high school diploma or General Educational  
2 Development equivalency certificate, and  
3 d. meet physical and mental standards as the Commissioner  
4 may prescribe. The scope of the physical and mental  
5 examinations for persons appointed as a Driver License  
6 Examiner or Senior Driver License Examiner shall be as  
7 prescribed by the Commissioner.

8 2. Any person appointed to the position of Driver License  
9 Examiner shall be required to complete satisfactorily a course of  
10 training as prescribed by the Commissioner.

11 E. Drunkenness, being under the influence of an intoxicating  
12 substance or any conduct not becoming an officer or public employee  
13 shall be sufficient grounds for the removal of any employee  
14 appointed pursuant to this section.

15 F. The annual salaries of personnel comprising this section  
16 shall be in accordance and conformity with the findings for  
17 Department of Public Safety law enforcement personnel of the State  
18 of Oklahoma Total Remuneration Study of 2013.

19 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
