6 An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
7 amending Section 1, Chapter 143, O.S.L. 2014 (10A
8 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 1-8-111), which relates to
9 annual credit reports for youth in Department
10 custody; providing age limitation on provision of
11 credit reports; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 143, O.S.L.
14 2014 (10A O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 1-8-111), is amended to read as
15 follows:

16 Section 1-8-111. A. The Department of Human Services shall
17 provide each youth in its custody sixteen (16) years and older an
18 annual credit report. The Department shall inform the court with
19 jurisdiction over the youth of any inaccuracies in a credit report
20 displaying evidence of identity theft or any other activity
21 fraudulently made on behalf of the youth in custody. The Department
22 may implement the requirements of this section in stages beginning
23 with youth in the independent living program whose credit rating may
24 inhibit employment and housing opportunities when the child is no
longer in custody.

1 B. Within one (1) year of the effective date of this act, the
2 Department of Human Services shall submit annual reports on the
3 implementation of the provisions of this act to the Chair and Vice
4 Chair of the Senate Health and Human Services Committee and the
5 Chair and Vice Chair of the House Human Services Committee. Such
6 reports shall include, but not be limited to, the number of youths
7 in the Department's custody receiving credit score reports, the
8 frequency of such reports, and administrative issues faced by the
9 Department in the implementation of this act. Such reports shall
10 continue to be issued by the Department until November 1, 2018.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
