AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Physician Manpower Training Commission; making appropriations; stating purposes; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain categories and amounts; providing for duties and compensation of employees; providing budgetary limitations; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain years; requiring certain budgeting procedures; prohibiting certain budgeting procedures; providing lapse dates; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Physician Manpower Training Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Physician Manpower Training Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law.

SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the Physician Manpower Training Commissions shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

1 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
3 upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law shall be set
4 by the Physician Manpower Training Commission. The Physician
5 Manpower Training Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30,
6 2016, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
7 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
8 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
9 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
10 the Oklahoma Statutes:

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14 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including
15 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16) or may be
17 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (hereafter FY-17).
18 Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June 30,
19 2016, and must be expended by November 15, 2016. Any funds
20 remaining after November 15, 2016, and not budgeted for FY-17, shall
21 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
22 year. Funds budgeted for FY-17 may be encumbered only through June
23 30, 2017. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2017, shall lapse
24 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

1 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
2 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-16, and not required to pay
3 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-17, after
4 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
5 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
6 from the FY-16 budget work program and after such revision has been
7 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

8 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
