6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to criminal procedure; granting
8 exclusive jurisdiction to Attorney General for
9 certain prosecutions; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 137 of Title 22, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The jurisdiction of a prosecution against a principal in the
16 commission of a public offense, when such principal is a state
17 elected official, state legislator, district court judicial officer,
18 appellate judicial officer or an appointee of a state board or state
19 commission at the time of the commission of the offense, is within
20 the sole and exclusive prosecutorial authority of the Attorney
21 General of Oklahoma. Such an action must be filed in the county of
22 residence of the state officer.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
