HOUSE BILL 2210

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-904, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 157, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 11-904), which relates to personal injury accidents; modifying certain penalty; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-904, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 157, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 11-904), is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-904. A. Any person who is involved in a personal injury accident while driving or operating a motor vehicle within this state and who is in violation of the provisions of subsection A of Section 11-902 of this title may be charged with a violation of the provisions of this subsection as follows:

1. Any person who is convicted of a violation of the provisions of this subsection shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor for the first offense and shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not less than ninety (90) days nor more than one (1) year,

1 and a fine of not more than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars  
2 (\$2,500.00); and

3 2. Any person who is convicted of a violation of the provisions  
4 of this subsection after having been previously convicted of a  
5 violation of this subsection or of Section 11-902 of this title  
6 shall be deemed guilty of a felony and shall be punished by  
7 imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not  
8 less than one (1) year and not more than five (5) years, and a fine  
9 of not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

10 B. 1. Any person who causes an accident resulting in great  
11 bodily injury to any person other than himself while driving or  
12 operating a motor vehicle within this state and who is in violation  
13 of the provisions of subsection A of Section 11-902 of this title  
14 may be charged with a violation of the provisions of this  
15 subsection. Any person who is convicted of a violation of the  
16 provisions of this subsection shall be deemed guilty of a felony  
17 punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of  
18 Corrections for not less than ~~one (1) year and not more than~~ ten  
19 (10) years, and a fine of not more than Five Thousand Dollars  
20 (\$5,000.00).

21 2. As used in this subsection, "great bodily injury" means  
22 bodily injury which creates a substantial risk of death or which  
23 causes serious, permanent disfigurement or protracted loss or  
24 impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
