6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2011,
8 Section 5-190, which relates to instruction and
9 continuing education of school district treasurers
10 and encumbrance clerks; authorizing instruction
11 completed within certain period prior to employment
12 to count toward certain requirement; and declaring an
13 emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-190, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 5-190. A. Before July 1, 2007, every school district
18 treasurer shall complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction
19 on school finance laws of this state, accounting, ethics, and the
20 duties and responsibilities of a school district treasurer.

21 B. Before July 1, 2007, every school district encumbrance clerk
22 shall complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction on school
23 finance laws of this state, accounting, ethics, and the duties and
24 responsibilities of a school district encumbrance clerk.

1 C. ~~Every~~ Except as otherwise provided for, every school
2 district treasurer and encumbrance clerk employed after July 1,
3 2007, shall be required, within nine (9) months after employment in
4 the position by a school district, to complete the instruction
5 required pursuant to subsections A and B of this section. Any
6 instruction as described in subsections A and B of this section
7 completed by the school district treasurer or encumbrance clerk
8 within three (3) years prior to employment in the position by the
9 school district shall count toward satisfying the requirements of
10 this subsection.

11 D. Every school district treasurer and encumbrance clerk shall
12 be required to complete a minimum of twelve (12) hours of continuing
13 education every three (3) years, in addition to the requirements of
14 subsections A and B of this section.

15 E. The requirements of this section shall not apply to any
16 county treasurer who also acts as a school district treasurer;
17 however, nothing herein shall prevent a county treasurer from
18 attending such training or continuing education.

19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
