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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.
8 2011, Section 85.55, which relates to the Oklahoma
9 State Recycling and Recycled Materials Procurement
10 Act; removing requirement for Director of Central
11 Services to coordinate and report certain
information; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 85.55, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 85.55 A. Each state public entity whether or not
16 subject to the Central Purchasing Act shall:

17 1. Be subject to the rules promulgated by the Purchasing
18 Division regarding the purchase of recycled products;

19 2. Establish management practices in accordance with the
20 provisions of the Oklahoma State Recycling and Recycled Materials
21 Procurement Act; and

22 3. Report by November 1 of each year to the Director of Central
23 Services the following:
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- 1 a. the total amount of waste paper and other recyclable
2 materials sold during the previous fiscal year,
3 b. the amount of procured recycled paper products and
4 other products manufactured with recycled materials,
5 and
6 c. the total amount of monies collected and expended to
7 implement the Oklahoma State Recycling and Recycled
8 Materials Procurement Act; and

9 ~~4. The Director shall coordinate the information provided by
10 state public entities and report and submit such information to the
11 Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and to the
12 Speaker of the House of Representatives on or before January 15 of
13 each year.~~

14 B. It is the intention of the Legislature that all state public
15 entities and other governmental subdivisions of this state
16 aggressively pursue procurement practices that encourage solid waste
17 reduction and development of markets for recyclable materials and
18 compost and shall, whenever practical, procure products containing
19 recycled materials.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
