5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to physicians; requiring certain
7 boards to promulgate certain rules relating to
8 physician advertising; providing for noncodification;
and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
13 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

14 The State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision and the
15 State Board of Osteopathic Examiners shall promulgate rules to
16 require that an allopathic physician or an osteopathic physician be
17 authorized to use the term "board certified" in any advertising for
18 his or her practice only if the specialty board that conferred the
19 certification and the certifying organization is a member board of
20 the American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS), the American Board
21 of Physician Specialties (ABPS) or the American Osteopathic
22 Association Bureau of Osteopathic Specialists (BOS).

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
