5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to debtor and creditor; prohibiting
7 company from reporting consumer for nonpayment of
8 slower Internet service to consumer reporting agency;
9 providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 160 of Title 24, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 If an Internet service provider company provides Internet
16 service that is slower than the advertised megabits-per-second
17 download and megabits-per-second upload speed, and the consumer
18 files a complaint with the Oklahoma Corporation Commission or the
19 Federal Communications Commission and refuses to pay for the slower
20 Internet service, the Internet service provider company shall not
21 report the consumer's nonpayment to a consumer reporting agency that
22 compiles and distributes consumer reports.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
