HOUSE BILL 2733

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to railroads; requiring certain notice be given to certain railroad employees; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 190 of Title 66, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Railway companies organized under the laws of this state or doing business within the state shall not require a member of a train crew to report for work, unless notice of no less than twenty-four (24) hours is given by the railway company to the member of the train crew.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
