7 An Act relating to counties; amending 19 O.S. 2011,  
8 Section 1004, which relates to the city-county park  
and recreation commission; increasing membership of  
9 commission; and providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 1004, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1004. The city-county park and recreation commission  
16 shall consist of ~~eleven (11)~~ twelve (12) members. Five of the  
17 members shall be appointed by the mayor of the city subject to  
18 approval of the governing body thereof. ~~Four~~ Five of the members  
19 shall be appointed by the board of county commissioners. The mayor  
20 of the city and the chairman of the board of county commissioners  
21 shall be members of the commission and shall be entitled to vote on  
22 all matters. The initial appointments by the city shall designate  
23 two members to serve a term of three (3) years, two members to serve  
24 a term of two (2) years, and one member to serve a term of one (1)

1 year. The initial appointments by the county shall designate ~~one~~  
2 ~~member~~ two members to serve a term of three (3) years, two members  
3 to serve a term of two (2) years, and one member to serve a term of  
4 one (1) year. Provided, that the terms of such initial appointees  
5 and the terms of all future appointees of both the city and county  
6 shall terminate July 31 of that year in which they expire,  
7 regardless of the calendar date when such appointments are made.  
8 Subsequent appointments of either the city or the county shall be  
9 for three-year terms, except in the case of an appointment to fill a  
10 vacancy in the membership of the commission, which latter  
11 appointment shall be for the balance of the unexpired term of the  
12 member whose death, resignation, or removal has created the vacancy.  
13 Members shall not be eligible to succeed themselves after serving  
14 two consecutive terms. A member of such commission once qualified  
15 can thereafter be removed only for misconduct or neglect of duty  
16 during his term of office after notice and hearing before the  
17 governing board that appointed him. All members of the commission  
18 shall serve thereon without compensation. Expenses which are  
19 incurred by members pursuant to prior specific authorization by the  
20 board of county commissioners and the governing body of the city  
21 shall be reimbursed, provided, that expenses incurred for  
22 transportation, meals and lodging shall be reimbursed only if  
23 incurred in connection with authorized travel outside the county.  
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1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.

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
