6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.  
8 2011, Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5, as last amended by  
9 Sections 1 and 2, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S.  
10 Supp. 2015, Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5), which relate  
11 to specialty license plates; eliminating the Jenks  
12 Trojans License Plate; providing for the re-creation  
13 of the Jenks Trojans License Plate as a financial  
14 assistance plate; creating the Bixby Spartans License  
15 Plate as a financial assistance plate; providing for  
16 design of license plates; authorizing certain  
17 licensing agreements; authorizing and limiting  
18 certain payments; and providing an effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as  
21 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.  
22 2015, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

23 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
24 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or  
membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other  
subject as provided by this section.

1 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
2 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
3 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
4 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
5 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
12 issued on a staggered system.

13 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
14 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
15 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
16 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
17 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
18 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
19 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
20 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
21 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
22 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
23 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
24 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
2 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
3 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of  
4 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
5 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license  
6 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
7 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
8 removed from the vehicle.

9 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special  
10 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special  
11 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission  
12 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications  
13 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax  
14 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective  
15 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null  
16 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are  
17 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time  
18 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

19 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
20 follows:

21 1. Round and Square Dance License Plates - such plates shall be  
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
23 round and square dancing;

1           2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People  
2 License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to the  
3 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and  
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

5           3. National Rifle Association License Plates - such plates  
6 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the  
7 Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any  
8 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle  
9 Association;

10          4. Masonic Fraternity License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of  
12 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a  
13 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic  
15 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for  
16 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the  
17 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in  
18 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall  
19 contain the Masonic emblem;

20          5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License  
21 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for  
22 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be  
23 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's  
24 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall  
2 contain the Shriner's emblem;

3 6. Balloonists License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
5 hot air ballooning in this state;

6 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall  
7 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member  
8 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an  
9 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a  
10 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an  
11 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an  
12 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate  
13 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate  
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star  
15 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

16 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of  
18 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of  
19 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
20 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus  
21 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights  
22 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the  
23 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation  
24

1 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of  
2 Columbus emblem;

3 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and  
4 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license  
5 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license  
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

7 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be  
8 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying  
9 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag  
10 membership in Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed  
11 in consultation with Ducks Unlimited;

12 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be  
13 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons  
14 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in  
15 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in  
16 consultation with Kiwanis International;

17 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates  
18 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a  
19 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified  
20 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a  
22 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed  
23 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public  
24 Accountants;

1 13. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates  
2 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate  
3 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons  
4 applying for such license plate must show proof of official  
5 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,  
6 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or  
7 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state  
8 emergency management department head;

9 14. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates  
10 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
11 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and  
12 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian  
13 Conservation Corps;

14 15. Rotarian License Plates - such plates shall be designed and  
15 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian  
16 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license  
17 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton  
18 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the  
19 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate  
20 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license  
21 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian  
22 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

23 16. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plates - such  
24 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the

1 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and  
2 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the  
3 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

4 17. Humane Society License Plates - such plates shall be  
5 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
6 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued  
7 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to  
8 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate  
9 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

10 18. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,  
12 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this  
13 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons  
14 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon  
15 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.  
16 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of  
17 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
18 personalized license plates;

19 19. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plates - such  
20 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business  
21 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of  
22 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in  
23 consultation with American Business Clubs;

1           20. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plates - such plates  
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate  
3 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States  
4 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall  
5 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central  
6 Oklahoma;

7           21. Oklahoma Aquarium License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
8 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
9 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in  
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

11           22. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plates - such plates  
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
13 support for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates  
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public  
15 School System;

16           23. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plates - such  
17 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of  
18 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the  
19 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

20           24. Parrothead Club License Plates - such plates shall be  
21 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead  
22 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any  
23 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as  
24 for personalized license plates;

1           25. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plates - such plates  
2 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the  
3 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed  
4 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

5           26. Electric Lineman License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
6 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
7 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed  
8 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's  
9 Association;

10           27. Alpha Kappa Alpha License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
11 be designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa  
12 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in  
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha  
14 Sorority;

15           28. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License  
16 ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any  
17 person wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities  
18 and fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council  
19 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
20 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council  
21 Incorporated;

22           29. Organ, Eye and Tissue License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
23 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate  
24 support and increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation.

1 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the State  
2 Department of Health;

3 30. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License ~~Plate~~ Plates  
4 - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to  
5 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.  
6 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central  
7 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

8 31. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated  
9 License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to  
10 persons wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and  
11 Community Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall  
12 be designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders  
13 of America Incorporated;

14 32. Delta Sigma Theta License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
15 be designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma  
16 Theta Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in  
17 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority  
18 Incorporated;

19 33. Omega Psi Phi License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
20 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi  
21 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
22 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Incorporated;

23 34. Alpha Phi Alpha License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
24 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha

1 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
2 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity  
3 Incorporated;

4 35. 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System of Highways  
5 License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to  
6 persons wishing to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the  
7 Interstate System of Highways. The license plates shall be designed  
8 in consultation with the American Association of State Highway and  
9 Transportation Officials;

10 36. Kappa Alpha Psi License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi  
12 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
13 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity  
14 Incorporated;

15 37. Sigma Gamma Rho License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
16 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Sigma Gamma Rho  
17 Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with  
18 the Oklahoma Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Incorporated.  
19 Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Sigma  
20 Gamma Rho License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,  
21 2013;

22 38. Multiple Sclerosis License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
23 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
24 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the  
2 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

3 39. Frederick Douglass High School License Plates - such plates  
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
5 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.  
6 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of  
7 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

8 40. United States Air Force Academy License Plates - such  
9 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
10 demonstrate support for the United States Air Force Academy;

11 41. In God We Trust License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
12 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be  
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

14 42. National Weather Center License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
15 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
16 support for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall  
17 be designed in consultation with representatives of the National  
18 Weather Center Directors;

19 43. Make-A-Wish Foundation License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
20 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate  
21 support for the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be  
22 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National  
23 Make-A-Wish Foundation;

1           44. South Central Section PGA Foundation License ~~Plate~~ Plates -  
2 such plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to  
3 demonstrate support for the South Central Section PGA Foundation.  
4 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the South  
5 Central Section PGA Foundation;

6           45. Putnam City High School License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
8 support for Putnam City High School. The plates shall be designed  
9 in consultation with representatives of Putnam City High School  
10 Alumni Association, Inc.;

11           46. Autism Awareness License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness  
13 of autism. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with  
14 the Oklahoma Autism Network;

16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
17 support for the Oklahoma Blood Institute. The license plates shall

20 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is a  
21 member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority or Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. The  
22 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
23 chapters of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Incorporated and Phi Beta Sigma  
24 Fraternity Incorporated;

1           49. Star Spencer High School License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
3 support for Star Spencer High School located in Oklahoma City. The  
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the  
5 Star Spencer High School Alumni Association. Subject to the  
6 provisions of subsection A of this section, the Star Spencer High  
7 School License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,  
8 2015;

9           50. Northeast High School License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
10 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
11 support for Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The  
12 plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the  
13 Northeast High School Alumni Association;

14           51. Oklahoma City Central High School License ~~Plate~~ Plates -  
15 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
16 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni  
17 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with  
18 representatives of the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni  
19 Association;

20           52. Historic Greenwood District License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such  
21 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
22 music festivals held in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa,  
23 Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with  
24 the Greenwood Cultural Center;

1           53. Oklahoma Rifle Association License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such  
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
3 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Rifle Association. The plates  
4 shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the  
5 Oklahoma Rifle Association;

6           54. Oklahoma City Thunder License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
8 support for the Oklahoma City Thunder. The license plate shall be  
9 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Thunder  
10 organization;

11           55. Ovarian Cancer Awareness License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to increase  
13 awareness of ovarian cancer. The license plate shall be designed in  
14 consultation with the HOPE in Oklahoma organization;

15           56. BMW Car Club of America License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
17 support for the BMW Car Club of America. The plates shall be issued  
18 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to  
19 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license  
20 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Sunbelt Chapter of  
21 the BMW Car Club of America. Subject to the provisions of  
22 subsection A of this section, the BMW Car Club of America License  
23 Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2013;

1           57. Don't Tread On Me License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall  
2 be designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem  
3 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden  
4 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
5 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

6           58. Oklahomans for the Arts License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
8 support for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts  
9 education. The plates shall be designed in consultation with  
10 Oklahomans for the Arts;

11           59. Oklahoma City Barons License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
13 support for the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be  
14 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization.  
15 The license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination  
16 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

17           60. Oklahoma City Redhawks License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates  
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
19 support for the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be  
20 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks  
21 organization;

22           61. Tulsa Shock License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
24

1 the Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in  
2 consultation with the Tulsa Shock organization;

3 62. Tulsa Oilers License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

4 plates shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag  
5 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the  
6 original Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in  
7 consultation with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

8 68. Tulsa 66ers License ~~Plate~~ Plates - such plates shall be  
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
10 the Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with  
11 the Tulsa 66ers Organization; and

17 be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the  
18 Frederick School District and shall be designed in consultation with  
19 representatives of the Frederick School District.

20 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)  
21 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by  
22 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise  
23 provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows:  
24 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be

1 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be  
2 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
3 Registration Act and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the  
4 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in  
5 Section 1104 of this title.

6 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as  
7 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.  
8 2015, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

9 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
10 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
11 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide  
12 financial assistance as provided by this section.

13 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
14 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
15 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
16 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
17 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

18 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
19 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
20 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
21 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
22 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
23 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
24 issued on a staggered system.

1           The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
2 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
3 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
4 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
5 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
6 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
7 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
8 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
9 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
10 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
11 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

13           If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
14 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
15 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of  
16 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
17 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license  
18 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
19 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
20 removed from the vehicle.

21           For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,  
22 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax  
23 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid  
24 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by

1 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the  
2 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall  
3 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are  
4 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time  
5 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

6 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
7 follows:

8 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates  
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
10 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As  
11 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
12 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

13 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall  
14 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
15 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in  
16 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
17 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide  
18 general public environmental education program created pursuant to  
19 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such  
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination  
21 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
22 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued  
23 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated  
24 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee

1 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by  
2 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in  
3 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned  
4 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

5 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
6 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.  
7 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four  
8 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a  
9 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an  
10 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.  
11 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
12 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
13 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any  
14 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may  
15 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated  
16 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon  
17 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire  
18 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief  
19 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in  
20 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

21 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
22 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &  
23 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and  
24 the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living Memorial;

1           4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
3 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in  
4 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
5 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in  
6 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in  
7 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may  
8 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license  
9 plates.

10           As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
11 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of  
12 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13           5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be  
14 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
15 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State  
16 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child  
17 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
18 the prevention of child abuse.

19           As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
20 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

21           6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -  
22 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
23 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The  
24 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers

1 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized  
2 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States  
3 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if  
4 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United  
5 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be  
6 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or  
7 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not  
8 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate  
9 issued;

10 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in  
12 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
13 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society  
14 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

15 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be  
16 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother  
17 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
18 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving  
19 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,  
20 Oklahoma;

21 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be  
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of  
23 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal  
24 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided

1 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited  
2 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in  
3 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

4 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates  
5 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency  
6 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical  
7 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
8 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical  
9 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in  
10 consultation with the state association of emergency medical  
11 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
12 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical ~~Technician~~  
13 Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2  
14 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be  
16 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of  
17 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount  
18 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act  
19 Revolving Fund;

20 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall  
21 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
22 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates  
23 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims  
24 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected

1 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for  
2 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use  
3 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to  
4 provide services to crime victims;

5 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates  
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
7 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The  
8 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
9 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of  
10 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -  
11 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to  
12 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

13 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,  
14 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the  
15 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
16 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued  
17 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in  
18 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to

21 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall  
22 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag  
2 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an

5 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates  
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate  
7 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The  
8 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
9 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As  
10 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
11 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial  
12 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of  
13 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be  
15 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
16 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the  
17 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to  
18 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license  
19 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate  
20 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three  
21 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as  
22 follows:

- 23 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education  
24 Reform Revolving Fund,

- 1           b.    five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher  
2                    Education Revolving Fund,

19           used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate  
20           shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in  
21           combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or  
22           emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.  
23           Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
24           eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to

1 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any

8 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such  
9 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
10 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall  
11 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters  
12 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.  
13 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.  
14 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into  
15 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any  
16 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts  
17 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide  
18 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty  
19 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

20 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such  
21 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the  
22 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and  
23 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state  
24 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and

1 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
2 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of  
3 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5  
4 of this title;

5 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates  
6 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
7 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and  
8 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma  
9 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee  
10 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation  
11 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and  
12 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

13 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates  
14 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of  
15 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for  
16 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive  
17 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and  
18 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates  
19 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation  
20 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human  
21 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall  
22 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury  
23 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the  
24

1 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act  
2 specifically for created families;

3 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,

16 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
17 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.7 of this title;

18 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
19 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions  
20 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any  
21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,  
22 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be  
23 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation

12 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the  
13 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
