HOUSE BILL 2782

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to professions and occupations; amending Section 14, Chapter 270, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1151.25), which relates to the Roofing Contractor Registration Act; providing exemption to the commercial roofing examination; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 14, Chapter 270, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1151.25), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1151.25 A. Except as otherwise provided in the Roofing Contractor Registration Act, on and after July 1, 2015, every roofing contractor offering to engage in or engaging in performing commercial roofing contractor work in this state shall be required to take and successfully pass a commercial roofing examination approved under the provisions of this act, and be in compliance with all other provisions of the act and rules thereof before acting or being endorsed as a commercial roofing contractor.

1 B. Examinations for a commercial roofer endorsement shall be
2 uniform and practical in nature and sufficiently strict to test the
3 qualifications and fitness of the applicants for endorsement.
4 Examinations shall be in whole or in part in writing. Examinations
5 shall be offered at least monthly; dates, times and locations are to
6 be determined by the registrar or third-party vendor with approval
7 of the registrar.

8 C. Any applicant initially failing to pass the examination
9 shall not be permitted to take another examination for a period of
10 thirty (30) days. Any applicant subsequently failing to pass the
11 examination shall not be permitted to take another examination for a
12 period of ninety (90) days. However, in a declared state of
13 emergency, the examination shall be available as often as possible
14 as determined by the registrar.

15 D. No commercial roofer endorsement shall be renewed unless the
16 qualifying party has completed the required hours of continuing
17 education, as determined and approved by the Committee of Roofing
18 Examiners and the Construction Industries Board.

19 E. A roofing contractor that provides evidence to the Board of
20 performing continued roofing contractor work for at least ten (10)
21 years prior to January 1, 2015, shall be exempt from the provisions
22 of this section.
