AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to occupational therapy; requiring State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision to promulgate certain rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 888.16 of Title 59, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision shall promulgate rules that require an individual who is a licensed occupational therapist in good standing in another state to automatically receive a license to practice occupational therapy in this state, even if the individual has not received the number of continuing education hours required in this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
