RESOLUTION 1027

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution disapproving proposed permanent rule of the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission; stating legislative intent; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to designate the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, determine that a rule is not consistent with legislative intent and disapprove any rule or portion thereof at any time; and

WHEREAS, proposed permanent rule OAC 45:30-5-6, subsection (d), paragraph (1), subparagraph c, which reads in part "sexual orientation", which was proposed by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission, does not reflect the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

1 SECTION 1. The Legislature hereby disapproves the following
2 language in the proposed permanent rule which was adopted by the
3 Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission on February 20, 2015:
4 OAC 45:30-5-6, subsection (d), paragraph (1), subparagraph c,
5 "sexual orientation", which does not reflect the intent of the
6 Oklahoma Legislature.

7 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is directed to distribute
8 copies of this resolution to the Governor, the Alcoholic Beverage
9 Laws Enforcement Commission, and the editor of "The Oklahoma
10 Register".
