AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution relating to the Rules of the Oklahoma House of Representatives; amending Section 9.1 of House Rule Nine, which relates to the daily order of business of the House of Representatives; modifying daily order of business to include the Official Salute to the Oklahoma State Flag.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 9.1 of House Rule 9 of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 9.1 The following Order of Business shall be followed each day:

1. Roll Call;
2. Prayer, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;
3. Inspirational Message by Chaplain on Thursday mornings, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;

1 4. Introduction of the Veteran of the Week on Monday mornings,
2 the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority
3 Floor Leader;

4 5. Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of
5 America, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the
6 Majority Floor Leader;

7 6. Official Salute to the Oklahoma State Flag, as adopted by
8 the 38th Oklahoma Legislature, the timing of which shall be left to
9 the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;

10 7. Introduction of a Doctor and/or Nurse of the Day, the timing
11 of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor
12 Leader;

13 ~~7.~~ 8. Correction of the Previous Day's Journal;

14 ~~8.~~ 9. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on Second
15 Reading, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the
16 Majority Floor Leader;

17 ~~9.~~ 10. Assignment or Reassignment of Bills and Resolutions, the
18 timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority
19 Floor Leader;

20 ~~10.~~ 11. Bills, Resolutions, Conference Committee Reports and
21 Joint Committee Reports scheduled by the Speaker of the House or the
22 Speaker's designee; and

23 ~~11.~~ 12. Motions placing new business before the House. The
24 Majority Floor Leader shall schedule said motions upon the same

1 legislative day, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion
2 of the Majority Floor Leader.
