6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution relating to the Secretary of Finance,
8 Administration, and Information Technology; creating
9 a Resolution of No Confidence; and directing
10 distribution.

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12 WHEREAS, the position of the Secretary of Finance,
13 Administration, and Information Technology has been created,
14 reaffirmed, and authorized by Governor Mary Fallin pursuant to
15 Executive Order 2015-07; and

16 WHEREAS, Executive Order 2015-07 charges the Secretary of
17 Finance, Administration, and Information Technology with oversight
18 of the Abstractors Board, Accountancy Board, Alternative Fuels
19 Technician Examiners and Board, the State Auditor and Inspector, the
20 State Banking Board and the State Banking Department, Bipartisan
21 Legislative Apportionment Commission, the State Bond Advisor, the
22 Council of Bond Oversight, the Building Bonds Commission, the
23 Capital Investment Board, the Capitol-Medical Center Improvement and
24 Zoning Commission, the State Capitol Preservation Commission, Cash

1 Management Oversight Committee, Compensation and Unclassified
2 Positions Review Board, Construction Industries Board, Consumer
3 Credit Commission and Department of Consumer Credit, Contingency
4 Review Board, Development Finance Authority, Electronic and
5 Information Technology Accessibility Advisory Council, the State
6 Employee Assistance Program and Advisory Council, Employee Insurance
7 and Benefits Board, the State Board of Equalization, the
8 Firefighters Pension and Retirement System and Board, Committee of
9 Home Inspector Examiners, the Incentive Approval Committee, the
10 Committee for Incentive Awards for State Employees, the Insurance
11 Commissioner and State Insurance Department, the Oklahoma Commission
12 on Interstate Cooperation, the Commissioners of the Land Office, Law
13 Enforcement Retirement System and Board, Board of Legislative
14 Compensation, Life and Health Insurance Guaranty Association and
15 Board of Directors, Long-Range Capital Planning Commission, the
16 Lottery Commission and Board of Trustees, the Office of Management
17 and Enterprise Services, the Manufactured Home Advisory Committee,
18 Market Assistance Association and Board of Directors, Merit
19 Protection Commission, Motor Vehicle Commission, Oversight Committee
20 for State Employee Charitable Contributions, the State Pension
21 Commission, Police Pension and Retirement System and Board, Program
22 Development and Credit Review Committee, Public Employees Relations
23 Board, Public Employees Retirement System and Board, Securities
24 Commission and Department of Securities, the State Credit Union

1 Board, State Governmental Technology Applications Review Board, the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission, Teachers' Retirement System Board of
3 Trustees and the Teachers' Retirement System, the State Treasurer,
4 and the Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission, along with other
5 duties including but not limited to those outlined in Section 840-
6 1.6A of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
8 Statutes, the Governor has the sole power to remove any officers
9 whom she appoints due to incompetency, neglect of duty, or
10 malfeasance in office; and

11 WHEREAS, the current appointed Secretary of Finance,
12 Administration, and Information Technology, Preston Doerflinger, has
13 on multiple occasions used his position to engage in overtly
14 political actions, broadcasts, and writings; has acted in his
15 official capacity in a manner that presents a clear conflict of
16 interest through continued political engagement; and has committed
17 acts of moral turpitude, adversely affecting the performance of his
18 official duties.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
20 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

21 THAT the Legislature of the State of Oklahoma does hereby issue
22 to Governor Mary Fallin a Resolution of No Confidence in Preston
23 Doerflinger's ability to carry out his official duties as Oklahoma

1 State Secretary of Finance, Administration, and Information
2 Technology.

3 THAT Governor Mary Fallin immediately suspend, without pay and
4 benefits, Preston Doerflinger and solicit applications for a
5 professionally qualified replacement.

6 THAT in the event a suitable replacement cannot be located in a
7 timely manner, the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State
8 Senate with the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives
9 shall each provide a list of suitable candidates from which the
10 Governor shall choose a replacement.

11 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Secretary
12 of Finance, Administration, and Information Technology and the
13 Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
