SENATE BILL 1008

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to driver licenses; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-114, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2013, (47 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 6-114), which relates to replacement licenses; authorizing certain renewals; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-114, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2013 (47 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 6-114), is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-114. A. 1. In the event that a driver license is lost, destroyed or requires the updating of any information, restriction or endorsement displayed thereon, the person to whom such license was issued may obtain a replacement thereof upon payment of the required fee and by furnishing both primary and secondary proofs of identity to the Department of Public Safety. If application is made at a motor license agency or subagency, the agent or subagent shall immediately verify the identity of the person, by means of both primary and secondary proofs of identity,

1 and the eligibility of the person by contacting the Department for
2 verification and approval. If the person is an alien, the person
3 shall appear before a driver license examiner of the Department and,
4 after furnishing primary and secondary proofs of identity as
5 required in this section, shall be issued a replacement driver
6 license for a period which does not exceed the lesser of:

- 7 a. the expiration date of the license being replaced, or
- 8 b. the expiration date on the valid documentation
9 authorizing the presence of the person in the United
10 States, as required by paragraph 9 of subsection A of
11 Section 6-103 of this title.

12 2. The cost of a replacement license shall be Twenty Dollars
13 (\$20.00), of which Two Dollars (\$2.00) shall be apportioned as
14 provided in Section 1104 of this title, Three Dollars (\$3.00) shall
15 be remitted to the State Treasurer to be credited to the General
16 Revenue Fund, and Five Dollars (\$5.00) shall be credited to the
17 Department of Public Safety Computer Imaging System Revolving Fund
18 to be used solely for the purpose of administering and maintaining
19 the computer imaging system of the Department, and Ten Dollars
20 (\$10.00) to the Revolving Fund of the Department of Public Safety.

21 3. The Department shall promulgate rules prescribing forms of
22 primary and secondary identification acceptable for replacement of
23 an Oklahoma driver license.

1 B. Any person desiring to add or remove an endorsement or
2 endorsements or a restriction or restrictions to any existing driver
3 license, when authorized by the Department of Public Safety, shall
4 obtain a replacement license with said endorsement or endorsements
5 or said restriction or restrictions change thereon and shall be
6 charged the fee for a replacement license as provided in subsection
7 A of this section.

8 C. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 6-201 of this
9 title, upon completion of serving a sentence of confinement by a
10 non-violent offender, if the offender had a valid driver license
11 before incarceration, the offender shall be eligible for a renewal
12 license as outlined in this section.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
