6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Construction Industries Board;  
8 amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1000.2, as amended by  
9 Section 2, Chapter 332, O.S.L. 2013 (59 O.S. Supp.  
10 2015, Section 1000.2), which relates to the  
Construction Industries Board; modifying membership;  
providing an effective date; and declaring an  
emergency.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1000.2, as  
14 amended by Section 2, Chapter 332, O.S.L. 2013 (O.S. Supp. 2015,  
15 Section 1000.2), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1000.2. A. The Construction Industries Board is hereby  
17 created to continue until July 1, 2016, in accordance with the  
18 provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The Board shall regulate the  
19 plumbing, electrical and mechanical trades, the building and  
20 construction inspectors, and the roofing contractors through the  
21 powers and duties set forth in the Construction Industries Board Act  
22 and in the respective licensing or registration acts for such  
23 trades, or as otherwise provided by law.

1 B. 1. Beginning ~~July 1, 2013~~ July 1, 2016, the Board shall be  
2 composed of seven (7) members appointed by the Governor with the  
3 advice and consent of the Senate, as follows:

4 a. ~~two members~~ one member shall have at least ten (10)  
5 years' experience in the plumbing trade, of which one  
6 shall be a plumbing contractor and one shall be a  
7 journeyman plumber,

8 b. two members shall have at least ten (10) years'  
9 experience in the electrical trade, of which one shall  
10 be an electrical contractor and one shall be a  
11 journeyman electrician,

12 c. ~~two members~~ one member shall have at least ten (10)  
13 years' experience in the mechanical trade, of which  
14 one shall be a mechanical contractor and one shall be  
15 a mechanical journeyman, ~~and~~

16 d. one member shall have at least ten (10) years'  
17 experience as a building and construction inspector,  
18 and

19 e. two members shall be residents of this state appointed  
20 as members at-large.

21 2. Members shall be appointed for staggered terms of four (4)  
22 years, as designated by the Governor. Members shall continue in  
23 office until a successor is appointed by the Governor. The Governor  
24 shall fill all vacancies and unexpired terms in the same manner as

1 the original appointment of the member whose position is to be  
2 filled. A member may be removed by the Governor at any time.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
