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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public safety communication  
8 system; amending Section 1, Chapter 174, O.S.L. 2015  
9 (62 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 35.6.1), which relates  
10 to the Criminal Justice Information Systems Center  
11 for Excellence; modifying title of system; modifying  
inclusions; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 174, O.S.L.  
14 2015 (62 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 35.6.1), is amended to read as  
15 follows:

16 Section 35.6.1. A. In order to comply with Executive Orders  
17 and federal and state statutory and regulatory requirements related  
18 to the criminal justice information system and the public safety  
19 communication system, to support agencies within the Oklahoma Safety  
20 and Security Cabinet and the Transportation Cabinet, and to  
21 accomplish the purposes of the Information Services Division of the  
22 Office of Management and Enterprise Services, there is hereby  
23 established the "Criminal Justice Information Systems Center for  
24 Excellence" and the "Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Radio System

1 Cooperative" to provide shared infrastructure services for such  
2 agencies. The Criminal Justice Information Systems Center for  
3 Excellence and Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Radio System  
4 Cooperative shall be under the administrative control of the Chief  
5 Information Officer.

6 B. In establishing and operating the Criminal Justice  
7 Information Systems Center for Excellence and the Land Mobile Radio  
8 Public Safety Radio System Cooperative through the Information  
9 Services Division, the Chief Information Officer shall collaborate  
10 with agencies subject to criminal justice information system  
11 requirements and radio communications requirements. The Chief  
12 Information Officer, in conjunction with the Commissioner of Public  
13 Safety and the Director of the Department of Transportation, shall  
14 establish an appropriate governance model for priorities, shared  
15 services and systems for the Criminal Justice Information Systems  
16 Center for Excellence and the Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Radio  
17 System Cooperative. The Chief Information Officer may utilize the  
18 Criminal Justice Information Systems Center for Excellence and the  
19 Land Mobile Radio Public Safety Radio System Cooperative to  
20 accomplish such other purposes as may be necessary for the  
21 administration of the duties of the Information Services Division  
22 that are related to stringent federal or state data security  
23 requirements, provided the security of investigative and law  
24 enforcement information and support systems is not jeopardized.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.

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
