6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care  
8 Authority; directing Authority to initiate certain  
9 procedures for certain purposes; requiring proposals  
10 to include certain provisions; requiring certain  
11 credentials for proposals; directing promulgation of  
12 rules; providing for codification; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5055 of Title 63, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall initiate requests  
19 for proposals for drug screening services. Such proposals shall  
20 include quantitative and qualitative testing methods, as well as  
21 predictive analytics programs to identify prescription drug abuse by  
22 participants in the Oklahoma Medicaid Program.

23 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall only consider  
24 proposals for drug screening services for facilities possessing a  
certificate of registration as a high complexity laboratory as

1 defined by 42 C.F.R. 493.2 et seq. and accredited by the College of  
2 American Pathologists.

3 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate  
4 rules to implement the provisions of this act.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
