6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to daylight saving time; creating the
8 Daylight Saving Time Preservation Pact to continue
9 daylight saving time year-round; providing for other
10 states to adopt pact; providing for non-observance of
11 certain federal law upon adoption by certain states;
and providing for codification.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2010 of Title 25, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. There is hereby established the "Daylight Saving Time
17 Preservation Pact" consisting of this state and any other state
18 desiring to continue daylight saving time year-round.

19 B. The State of Oklahoma hereby exempts all areas of the state
20 and its political subdivisions from the daylight saving time
21 provisions of 15 United States Code, Section 260(a).

22 C. In the year in which at least twenty (20) states, including
23 the states directly bordering our state, Arkansas, Colorado, Kansas,
24 Missouri, New Mexico and Texas, have passed legislation entering

1 those states into the Daylight Saving Time Preservation Pact, each
2 state will switch clocks to daylight saving time for the last time
3 and daylight saving time will be declared the standard time. After
4 this time, Oklahoma and all other participating states will no
5 longer observe the federal law governing daylight saving time.
