6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to statutes and reports; amending 75
8 O.S. 2011, Section 19, which relates to possession of
9 statute books; modifying penalty for failure to
10 deliver statutes; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 75 O.S. 2011, Section 19, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 19. Any person holding office in this state, or in any
15 county or township thereof, upon relinquishing office to his
16 successor, who fails or refuses to deliver to his or her successor
17 in office all the volumes of laws that have come into his or her
18 possession by virtue of holding such office shall be liable, upon
19 conviction, to a fine of ~~Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), or to imprisonment~~
20 ~~in the county jail not exceeding twenty (20) days~~ One Thousand
21 Dollars (\$1,000.00). The person succeeding to the office of such
22 delinquent shall file a complaint against ~~him~~ the previous office
23 holder. If the person so failing or refusing to deliver said
24 volumes of laws can show to the satisfaction of the judge that said

1 volumes have been destroyed or stolen in a manner for which the said
2 delinquent person should not be held responsible, then no penalty
3 shall be imposed.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
